



One of my passions is cooking great tasting nutritious foods. Since Grouper is the fish of the month, I would like to share with you one of my favorite Grouper recipes.

### Margarita Grouper Fillets

6 (6 ounce) grouper fillets

3/4 teaspoon salt, divided

1/4 cup fresh cilantro leaves

1/4 cup chopped onion

1 tablespoon sugar

1 tablespoon finely chopped seeded Serrano chili

3 tablespoons fresh lime juice

1 tablespoon tequila

1 tablespoon vegetable oil

1 garlic clove, chopped

Chopped chives (optional)

Lime Wedges

Place the grouper fillets in a single layer in a 13 x 9 inch Pyrex baking dish. Sprinkle with ¼ tsp salt. Combine ½ tsp salt, cilantro and the next 7 ingredients (cilantro through garlic clove) in a blender or food processor. Process until smooth. Pour cilantro mixture over the fillets. Turn to coat. Marinate in the refrigerator 30 minutes, turning once.

Prepare grill.

Remove fish from baking dish; discard marinade. Place fish on grill rack coated with cooking spray; grill 5 minutes on each side or until fish flakes easily when tested with a fork. Garnish fish with chopped chives and lime wedges.

Left over Margarita Grouper Fillets work great for Fish Tacos. Use flour tortillas, shredded cole slaw mix and a yogurt, lime, cilantro sauce.

### **Fishing Events Director**

New Year's Day came in with a big bang, as quite a few of our members took advantage of the ideal weather conditions and caught some fish, mostly offshore. Here are some of the New Years Day results:

John Stockinger skippered a New Years Day group that consisted of Bob Bretts, John Gettinger, and Joe Udwari. They reported six Groupers, which were between 25.5" and 30", a 33.5" Amberjack, a 36" Cobia, and a 45" Barracuda.

Captains Marge and Jim Hoffman took out a group that consisted of Rich Brennan, Aaron Wagner, and Ron Topper. They reported a catch of ten Grouper which were between 26" and 29", and a 34" Amberjack.

Bud Johnson reported a catch of two 26" Gag Groupers and a 34" Amberjack.

Mark Maples and Paul Buchannan reported a catch of a 36" and 34" Cobia.

Rose Anne McCaffrey reported a very nice catch of a 32.5" Gag Grouper, this is 95.6 % of the ladies Grouper record of 34" caught by Margie Hoffman in 2014. This also puts Rose Anne in first place in the Grouper 2016 Master Angler Standing.

Mark Dillman reported a catch of a 36" Cobia and a Bonita.

Ron Stenberg reported a 24" Snook.

Indeed, New Years Day was a good day for fishing, as more than half of the fish reported for the month, were caught on New Years Day. It was an especially good day for Grouper, (unless of course, you happened to be a Grouper). Unfortunately, most of the last 20 days of January, weather conditions were very unfavorable; with lots of rain, heavy winds, and rough seas, that limited the rest of the month's fishing activities

**Our January Fish of the Month was Sheepshead** and it looks like Darlene and Vinnie Madsen caught a twin pair of "Bubba" Sheepsheads, as they both took 1<sup>st</sup> place in their divisions with fish measuring 21" and 24" respectively. 
Please don't forget that every new member has a star on his badge. Please go out of your way to say hello; make them feel welcome. Make a friend.

Not many communities can boast about a group that has formed a community alliance with their local police department to be the eyes and ears to help in keeping their community safe from illegal activities that might include boat theft, the taking of marine equipment and illegal netting activity.
