I'd like to thank Joe Udwari for his presentation on Grouper fishing at last month's General Membership meeting. As many of you know, Joe is a great fisherman who loves to share his knowledge to help others. His presentation was well received by the entire audience. I hope that some of the knowledge learned from Joe's presentation has helped you catch some Grouper which was our February Fish of the Month.

March's Fish of the Month is Spanish Mackerel. I have asked Fishin Frank to be our speaker in March. He or Robert will be discussing Spanish Mackerel as to how to catch them and where you may find them. I have found them running in some small schools down by Pine Island. We were looking for trout so naturally the larger mackerels stripped our lures right off as they have a very sharp bite. Speaking of Fishin Frank, his tent sale is March 24th. I highly encourage everyone to attend this event. He will have dozens of manufacturers on hand to share with everyone their latest products and to answer any questions you have. Expect a lot of people as the bargains are worth attending. Our club has helped with some traffic control and stood watch at some security points in the past. A well-deserved assist also goes to Jim McCarty for captaining the boat. The trio boated 5 grouper over 29" and a 26" Porgy. Great day guys!!!

As for the rest of the club, we had a monster month. 95 fish were entered and 6100 points were awarded. Five members will be getting their 1st Fish Hats at this month's meeting along with the awarding of a Silver, a Bronze, and a Lifetime Master Angler - Snook Pin.




The Month in Review (FEBRUARY)

Each day of the month PGI NMW members rise up in the night and early morning hours, launch their personal boats and go "On Patrol" to observe and report all suspicious boating or land activity to the Punta Gorda Police Department night dispatcher.


We prefer all members have a boat that they can use for their monthly patrol. However, you do not have to own a boat to become a member. You can act as "crew" during any other members patrol or, in the event of inclement weather or other unsafe "on-the-water" conditions, perform your 2-hour patrol at predesignated land locations in your vehicle.

The preferred boat size is 17 to 23 feet, with either a T-top or bow rail to display "Patrol Boat" signage that identifies your vessel as a PGI Neighborhood Marine Watch Patrol Boat.
