For the remainder of the year I will be lining up interesting guest speakers that cover a variety of topics related to our favorite past time. There will be some excellent professional guides like Rhett Morris talking about Tarpon fishing at our August meeting. I'll also be drawing on the deep knowledge within our club membership to present information on a variety of fishing topics. Because we all need some sort of dependable transportation to seek out fish I have asked Bob Davis of Davis Marine to discuss boat motor maintenance at our June meeting. And because those sometimes-dangerous summer pop up storms will be arriving soon Zac Maloch, meteorologist at WINK News, will be discussing what to watch out for at our upcoming May 8th meeting.

Incidentally, the real odds of the average person being struck by lightning *over the courses of his/her life is 1 in 15,000.* If you spend a lot of time on the water, as we Floridians do, your odds are even worse. The odds of your boat being struck by lightning is *1 in 1000*. And that's not a lifetime risk that's an *anytime risk*. Anyway, NOAA has made real time lightning strike data available to App developers- Google "lightening app NOAA". In addition to keeping you informed of storm activity these apps can give you a heads-up when lightening is in your area and allow you to see if it is moving toward you.


The Month in Review (MARCH)



If you can volunteer no more than 2-hours each month and have a boat, then you may want to consider becoming a member of one of the most unique community volunteer groups in Southwest Florida. Each day of the month PGI NMW members rise up in the night and early morning hours, launch their personal boats and go "On Patrol" to observe and report all suspicious boating or land activity to the Punta Gorda Police Department night dispatcher.

We prefer all members have a boat that they can use for their monthly patrol. However, you do not have to own a boat to become a member. You can act as "crew" during any other members patrol or, in the event of inclement weather or other unsafe "on-the-water" conditions, perform your 2-hour patrol at predesignated land locations in your vehicle.

The preferred boat size is 17 to 23 feet, with either a T-top or bow rail to display "Patrol Boat" signage that identifies your vessel as a PGI Neighborhood Marine Watch Patrol Boat.


