

## PUNTA GORDA ISLES FISHING CLUB JOHN'S FISHING REPORT





FWC in collaboration with NOAA Fisheries have announced a recreational red snapper season for Gulf state waters and Federal waters. A 40-day recreational red snapper season has been set for 2018 beginning June 11 and close July 21.

Gulf States (Texas, Louisiana, Mississippi, Alabama, and Florida) and NOAA have approved a pilot program, the Exempted Fishing Permit (EFP), to manage recreational red snapper fishing in state and federal waters. The pilot permit program will allow each state to manage the recreational red snapper fishing season. Under the EFP program each of the Gulf States will be setting the red grouper season through 2018 and 2019 for state and federal waters. States will be responsible for data collection and guota monitoring methodologies. While the overall Gulf quota for red snapper is 3.8 million pounds, each state will be managing to an agreed upon portion of the overall quota for their state and must close the season when their portion is reached, or if the overall Gulf quota is exceeded by another state or combination of states.

### Requirements?

To participate in the recreational red snapper season each recreational angler is required to sign up for a Gulf Reef Fishing Survey (GRFS). All anglers must follow the 16-inch total length minimum size limit and two fish bag limit and are encouraged to use descending devices or venting tools when releasing discards.

#### How do I sign up?

Retailers, stores, tackle shops, and tax collector offices or by calling or by calling 888-FISH-FLORIDA (347-4356). When purchasing or renewing any license at one of the above locations, please indicate to the clerk that you are a Gulf Reef Fish Angler and need to be marked as such. PAGE 10

#### **Online**

- Visit gooutdoorsflorida.com.
- Enter your Date of Birth and at least one of the other required "Lookup Method" identifiers (social security #, FWC customer ID, or Driver's license number). Note: You may have to create an account if this is your first time accessing the system.
- Click "Purchase a License."
- Scroll down to Saltwater Fishing and click the Add to Cart button next to "Gulf Reef Fish Angler."
- Make sure to print a copy.

Are you a Florida resident **65 or older** and exempt from needing a recreational saltwater fishing license? No worries! Though you are still required to click "Purchase a License," signing up as a "Gulf Reef Fish Angler" is no-cost. You are not required to purchase any other license, such as a recreational saltwater fishing license, or pay any other fees to participate.

#### What happens after you sign up?

- You will receive a printed license or need to print one from your computer if you purchase online with Gulf Reef Fish Angler printed on it. Carry this with you as proof that you signed up to participate in the Gulf Reef Fish Survey.
- In a year, make sure you renew. Renewal will be on an annual basis, just like a one-year fishing license.
- Many who sign up will be contacted by the FWC and asked if they would be willing to provide information about their Gulf reef fish fishing activities






