

PUNTA GORDA ISLES FISHING CLUB JOHN'S FISHING REPORT

Spending time fishing on a boat can be an enjoyable experience but it can change fast if someone becomes ill. A medical person isn't on board, you are far from the 911 system or a fast response from an ambulance. A fishing buddy is suddenly injured, becomes ill, or worse falls unconscious? Do you know what to do and have what you need? Sure, you do... because you attended the July 10 membership meeting in which Dr. Jim McCarty will be talking about the appropriate responses to health issues while on the water.

Have a safe and happy 4th of July!

At last month's membership meeting Rich Brennan brought up an incident that is becoming all too familiar to members fishing in the back country behind the East wall. It's jet skiers using the shallow narrow pathways and hairpin turns as a race track similar to that of an off-road motocross course. The high-pitched sound of jet skis roaring through mangrove areas and banking through tight turns not only shuts down fishing but shows little regard for the safety of other boaters in the area.

I recently spoke to an FWC enforcement officer to determine if such activities are a violation of FWC rules. The officer stated that if there are no positing's (manatee zone, no wake zone, minimum wake zone, etc.) then, most likely, the jet skiers were not in violation of any specific rule. However, he added; Operators of watercraft are responsible for operating their vessel in a reasonable and prudent manner with regard for other vessel traffic and circumstances to not endanger people or property. Further he stated that any willful disregard for others safety or property is a first-degree misdemeanor and a citation for reckless operation could be issued. He suggested a call to the FWC dispatch at 813.558.5050 (press option 7) would be the appropriate action to take if such an incident is observed.

Here's where the rub comes in. Upon receiving a call FWC will dispatch one of its officers to investigate the incident- if one is in the area. We all know that could take a long time- or may never happen at all. FWC officers cover a large territory (all of Charlotte County) and the scope of their enforcement efforts seem to be more narrowly focused on more immediate issues. Regardless of these constraints my suggestion is to act and call 813.558.5050 (press option 7) if you observe such careless operation or other rule violations.

Persistence and tenacity is what makes things happen- so expect a third and fourth attempt to resolve a problem. I can help too by organizing your efforts. E-mail me newspace@sbcglobal.net the time and date of your call to FWC and a brief description of the incident. I can then follow-up with FWC to help focus their efforts toward resolving the problem you are experiencing. We have over 400 members strong and numbers mean something considering the constraints impacting FWC.

I read some interesting info this month regarding the lack of reds. Some are now theorizing that red tide has played a big part in that it clobbered a couple of year classes 4 or 5 years ago. That said, I'm sure the current red tide situation isn't helping either. Remember the fish kill during the fall of 2016? That wiped out thousands (probably tens of thousands) of mullet. That had to seriously affect the mullet spawns for at least a couple of years. With finger mullet being a prime source of food for both reds and snook that has to have an effect also.

Ok, now for some good news. Lake Ontario is back to a more normal level, almost 3 feet below last year's disaster. Our break wall has been replaced, we have a new landscape wall and the lawn has been graded and seeded. The store is going 'gang busters" and we are both looking forward to returning to PGI in October.



A "gold fringe" on a Flag is sewn on by a person or organization and neither has the approval or disapproval of Congress. The fringe is completely optional BUT should never be used on a Flag which will be flown outdoors.

For more information on what our Flag means and the proper ways to display it, please check out a few of them on the Internet.






