FWC, at their September meeting, ordered the snook and redfish catch-and-release measure to expand to include Tampa Bay. Additionally, the catch-and-release date was extended through May 10th. The measure includes Charlotte County and specific locations can be viewed at the FWC website.

Hey, October is redfish month and I'm sure you would like to catch a bull red? Well then, you better plan on being at our upcoming October 9th meeting. Rich Brennan and Peter McGregor will be giving their version of how best to catch a bull redfish. Don't miss it!

Grass clippings don't seem to be a big deal... until they end up in our water...then it becomes what is called nutrient runoff. Scientist are now connecting the dots and are pointing to nutrient runoff as a significant contributor to the severity and longevity of red tide. Punta Gorda has a landscaping ordinance that specifically defines the rules to be followed concerning disposal of grass clippings. Sadly, just about every landscape contractor is guilty of violating that ordinance and with little concern for fines and violations. Please see my letter addressed to Mayor Rachel Keesling concerning the issue of enforcement of our landscaping ordinance.

Dear Mayor Keesling:

There is nothing more enjoyable than boating and fishing in our local waters. Unfortunately, that experience is being threatened by the nutrient runoff entering our estuary. Our landscaping ordinance was designed to prevent grass clippings from damaging our water. Sadly, that is not happening at a time when it is desperately needed.

Drive down any street while landscape contractors are mowing, and you will witness grass clippings being blown out onto streets, clippings blown from sidewalks and driveways into drainage ditches and grass clippings being blown from boat docks and seawalls into canals.

It's not that landscape contractors are unaware of the provision of the ordinance or the damage violations cause to our harbor. Issuance of a license is predicated upon completion of several hours of training on the features of the ordinance and its purpose. Yet, violations are commonplace and those responsible for the violations face no economic consequences.

Adherence to our landscaping ordinance languishes due to a lack of enforcement. Residents are assigned the responsibility of being the cop on the beat. Upon witnessing a violation of the landscape ordinance, it becomes the resident's responsibility to: "Take photos or video of the violation occurring, complete an affidavit stating the date time and facts, be available to testify in the case if the case proceeds to the code enforcement board". I think it is fair to conclude that most residents are unwilling to accept that responsibility- and for good reason. Meanwhile the pollution of our harbor continues.

Shouldn't city leaders reexamine how to better implement a critical ordnance at a time when its adherence is desperately needed?


The Month in Review (September)

If you can volunteer no more than 2-hours each month and have a boat, then you may want to consider becoming a member of one of the most unique community volunteer groups in Southwest Florida. Each day of the month PGI NMW members rise up in the night and early morning hours, launch their personal boats and go "On Patrol" to observe and report all suspicious boating or land activity to the Punta Gorda Police Department night dispatcher.

We prefer all members have a boat that they can use for their monthly patrol. However, you do not have to own a boat to become a member. You can act as "crew" during any other members patrol or, in the event of inclement weather or other unsafe "on-the-water" conditions, perform your 2-hour patrol at predesignated land locations in your vehicle.

The preferred boat size is 17 to 23 feet, with either a T-top or bow rail to display "Patrol Boat" signage that identifies your vessel as a PGI Neighborhood Marine Watch Patrol Boat.
