



May 2019 Presentation: Hurricane Boat Preparedness by Pete McGregor

Pete McGregor lost a boat in 2004 to hurricane Charley. The following slides represent lessons he learned and suggestions on how to prepare your boat for a hurricane.

Tie downs are available from Harbor Freight. Once a named storm develops, they will be hard to find.



Tie downs should securely hold the front and back of the boat.



Tie downs are anchored to the wood pilings with threaded eyebolts, securely holding the boat to the pilings. If the tie downs were anchored to the lift, the lift and boat could become unstable with high winds. For insurance purposes it's a good idea to take pictures.
