

FROM THE HELM

We live in a unique place. Jude Panetta and Chris Gibbons each caught a Smalltooth Sawfish and released them both unharmed. What's unusual about that you may ask? Smalltooth Sawfish are threatened with extinction. They were the first marine fish to receive federal protection as an endangered species under the Endangered Species Act in 2003. Even more unique Charlotte Harbor Estuary is the only place in America where they come to give birth to their young. Today, the species is only found off the coast of Florida but once were prevalent in Gulf waters from Florida to Texas and in the Atlantic waters as far north as North Carolina. It is estimated that their numbers are only 5% of what they once were.

Development of the waterfront areas in Florida and other southeastern states has changed or destroyed much of their habitat. This potentially affects areas in which Smalltooth Sawfish can give birth and juveniles can survive. Historically, Smalltooth Sawfish were often accidentally caught in fishing nets, particularly inshore gill nets. Because sawfish have the potential to damage fishing gear and pose a threat to fishermen, they were often killed rather than being released unharmed. While this threat has largely been reduced with the 1995 enactment of the Florida Net Ban Amendment, Smalltooth Sawfish are still incidentally caught in a variety of fishing gears today, including shrimp trawls, bottom longlines, and recreational hook-and-line gear.

Dr. Gregg Poulakis, a biologist with FWC, conducts research on Smalltooth Sawfish. He tracks their behavior by means of acoustic tags. By his estimates 50 to 60 females visit our harbor annually to give birth to a litter of 7 to 14 offspring that are 2-foot-long. Ouch! Fortunately, Mother Nature protects the mother from the harm of the newborns saws with a protective coating covering the saw that decays within a couple of weeks. Of that 50 to 60 count only 5 or 6 return repeatedly. The female after giving birth then leave the harbor and heads south toward the Everglades/Keys area. The newborns quickly head for skinny brackish water and remain there for a couple of years. The damage their saws can inflict on prey, or other predators, elevates them toward the top of the food chain. Their only natural enemies are Bull sharks and Dolphins. In a couple of years, the juveniles reach 7-foot-long and they too head south. Females take a year off to recuperate after giving birth and the 12-month gestation period begins over again.

Dr. Poulakis feels the waters of our harbor are very good for Smalltooth Sawfish as compared to other estuaries. However, he is concerned about nutrient runoff. Nutrient runoff is the process where too many nutrients (mainly nitrogen and phosphorus) cause the growth of algae. Severe algae growth consumes the oxygen in the water and blocks sunlight needed by plants (seagrass, mangroves). Because there are more people living in our coastal areas there is the potential for more nutrients entering our coastal waters. Small things each of us can do to minimize nutrient run off- direct lawn service employees to not blow grass clippings into canals and refrain from applying fertilizer in rainy season (June 1 thru September 30). Big things we can do- voice your opinion regarding Mosaic's recent renewal request to discharge wastewater. Much of it will go into the Peace River basin.

Dr. Poulakis requests that if you encounter a Smalltooth Sawfish to record its size, date, and location and report it. If a dead Smalltooth Sawfish is discovered, please tow it to an identifiable location and report that location to 941.993.7372.

PUNTA GORDA ISLES FISHING CLUB RANDY'S FISHING REPORT

The current dry spell has the harbor clearing up about six weeks ahead of schedule. Fishing near Smokehouse Bay yesterday saw water clarity through 3.5 feet. Water south in the harbor is still hot at 82.5 degrees.

Seeing a few redfish being sent in. Most of them are being caught on chunked Ladyfish fished very patiently near and under mangrove overhangs. Snook have slowed a bit but are still fairly plentiful. Lots of trout are being caught. The closure is now four months old and it's a little difficult to be objective; but I believe it has helped the population already.

There is a significant rule change on trout harvesting making its way through the process. The limit will be changed from 4 to 3 in our zone ("Southwest Florida"). Also, the slot will change to 15"-19" with one of the three allowed to be >19". As you know, that is 20" now. Also, Captains/guides will not be allowed to keep any trout on a for-hire trip.

Commercial limits are changing also. Today, licensed commercial fisherman can take 75 per boat per day. If there are two licenses in the boat, the limit is 150 with slot of 15"-24". New rule change would lower the daily take to 50 (or 100 with two fisherman in the vessel). Note that I have never encountered a commercial trout boat in the area, although they may be around.

From what I understand, the Wildlife Conservation Commission votes on it October 2 (the Staff is recommending "approval"). Then it's presented at the December 2019 public Commission meeting.

Note that this does NOT affect the current directive closing harvest of Snook, Redfish, and Trout through at least May of 2020 in our area.

My opinion on this (as a passionate trout fisherman) is that I'm all for it. Most of our club are two-person households...and three 15" sea trout are a generous meal. I think the sacrifice is worth the potential to grow the population considerably...especially after a year closure.

Our speaker for the October 8th is Rich Brennan who will discuss details on successful Redfish outings. Redfish is the Fish-of-Month for October. Our November speaker will be Captain Guy Carpenter from the enforcement division of the FWC.


DATE CHANGE

- Lack of barbells on lower jaw.

Fishing Tips:

Fish over grass in 2-4 feet depth and close to mangroves

Live shrimp or pinfish free line, under a cork or on a jig head

Gold Spoon or Paddletail lure on a jig head

Cut bait on bottom with catfish as by catch


The Month in Review (September)

PGI MARINE WATCH





If you can volunteer no more than 2-hours each month and have a boat, then you may want to consider becoming a member of one of the most unique community volunteer groups in Southwest Florida. Each day of the month PGI NMW members rise up in the night and early morning hours, launch their personal boats and go "On Patrol" to observe and report all suspicious boating or land activity to the Punta Gorda Police Department night dispatcher.

We prefer all members have a boat that they can use for their monthly patrol. However, you do not have to own a boat to become a member. You can act as "crew" during any other members patrol or, in the event of inclement weather or other unsafe "on-the-water" conditions, perform your 2-hour patrol at predesignated land locations in your vehicle.

The preferred boat size is 17 to 23 feet, with either a T-top or bow rail to display "Patrol Boat" signage that identifies your vessel as a PGI Neighborhood Marine Watch Patrol Boat.


