# PUNTA GORDA ISLES FISHING CLUB RANDY'S FISHING REPORT

Well, for the first time in a while, I can say that the Red Tide is finally abating. It's not GONE yet, but in my water travels, I don't smell it or see any new fish kill. FWC says it's back to "background concentrations" in and near the harbor. Water looks great and is probably a month ahead on clarity. Consistent problem is wind. We're getting a front every few days now so we've had to pick our days...and they may not be the best solunar days...but you gotta go right?

I want to communicate a few notes about weather, tides, and wind. Weather (actually barometric pressure) plays a very prominent role in fishing success. Rising pressure is very bad. Steady pressure after several days is good. Dropping pressure is great. Barometric pressures trump solunar and tidal inputs to successful fishing. So, fishing in the day of or before an approaching cold front is a good bet. Immediately after the front, is lock jaw time for a couple of days.


Next is tide. For the best success, you must have moving water. Incoming or outgoing. Incoming is preferable since that'll give you more acreage to access. PLUS if you're in unfamiliar territory, you can always safely traverse back out with the added water. I'm a believer in solunar data. Check the various apps and find one you're comfortable with. I try to choose to fish the better-rated overall days and within those days, I try to fish the major periods (and minors too). Solunar is based on sun AND moon locations and it isn't folklore...it's science.

Third is wind. I like to fish with a slight breeze. 5-9 mph is best. Trout hate sunlight, so the small ripples created by the breeze break up the direct sun rays, and they will hang out above the grass instead of in it. Note that persistent high winds have a huge effect on water levels. Thumb-rule is that a 20 mph NORTH wind for 24 hours in our harbor will remove a foot of water. And the opposite is true of a SOUTH wind...it'll add a foot.

# JANUARY FISH OF THE MONTH SHEEPSHEAD





LOOK AT THOSE TEETH! A MOUTH FULL OF MOLARS DESIGNED FOR CRUSHING SHELLS.

Sheepshead is a favorite species which requires slightly different techniques.

They most often feed on shellfish including dysters, crabs and shrimp, but can also be lured with other baits. Plastics and lures used for other species are usually not the best choices but some do well on Gulp srimp! However, being a bit contrarian, I plan on using the 2" Crusty Crab by Chasebaits. We'll see how that works



Sheepshead are often found around piers, docks and other locations where oysters, mussels and grass can be found. They generally do not gras and run like a Mangrove Snapper. Their bite is subtle as they try to crush the bait while moving it into their mouth. A quick "set the hook" on the first twitch will lose the fish. Instead, let the fish work the bait into its mouth so there is a better chance of a hookset in soft tissue rather than sliding off the hard roce of atternance.



### The Month in Review (December)





### PGI MARINE WATCH






If you can volunteer no more than 2-hours each month and have a boat, then you may want to consider becoming a member of one of the most unique community volunteer groups in Southwest Florida. Each day of the month PGI NMW members rise up in the night and early morning hours, launch their personal boats and go "On Patrol" to observe and report all suspicious boating or land activity to the Punta Gorda Police Department night dispatcher.

We prefer all members have a boat that they can use for their monthly patrol. However, you do not have to own a boat to become a member. You can act as "crew" during any other members patrol or, in the event of inclement weather or other unsafe "on-the-water" conditions, perform your 2-hour patrol at predesignated land locations in your vehicle.

The preferred boat size is 17 to 23 feet, with either a T-top or bow rail to display "Patrol Boat" signage that identifies your vessel as a PGI Neighborhood Marine Watch Patrol Boat.
