Now that the winds have abated, lots of us are getting out there. A few Harbor comments:

- 1)The harbor water is as clean as I've ever seen it (12 years). There are many areas in Pine Island Sound that are far dirtier than the harbor.
- 2) Water temp is at 80 degrees in many areas now.
- 3)No red tide...not even background concentrations.
- 4) Much of the previously pristine turtle grass areas are now coated with clearamber muck (I'm sure you smart people know what the official name for this snot is).
- 5)And finally, fishing pressure is very high due to the virus.

Even with the grass conditions, there are plenty of reports of trout, spanish mackerel, snook, jacks, and huge Ladyfish. I see bait gathering every morning just out from the Ponce Inlet Canal markers, Jug Creek Shoal, and a few boats at Bokeelia Reef.

April is Snook month. I see guides combing the canal exits with live greenbacks doing well. With the clear water, keep a good distance from your targeted spots.

I'm writing this on the eve of our March Club tournament. I applaud the leadership of Dennis and Jude to make the rewards ceremony "virtual" in light of the social distancing rules in effect. Get out there and have fun! We'll still distribute the "door" prizes!

Paul Whiting addresses monthly highlights in his section. A few additional notable items:


- Randy Douet represents less than 2% of the anglers reporting fish in March, However, he accounted for about 9% of the fish reported, and 11% of the points awarded for larger fish. Other than a modest 19.5" Spanish Mackerel, all of his reported fish were Spotted Seatrout. He had about 27% of all trout reported for the month. He achieved his goal of 2000 points for his second GMA (Seatrout) Star.
- Cindi Johnston earned her Grand Master Angler level and along the way landed a 46-inch barracuda.
- Dave Dyke was chasing his 6 ½ year personal best Spanish Mackerel at 22.5 inches. He caught TWO 22-inch fish in one day, in a tie for 1<sup>st</sup> place in Fish of the Month.
- Wayn Nelson caught a 32-inch Blackfin Tuna on a near-shore reef.
- Jan Holm caught a 21-inch Flounder at Ponce Park.
- In early April Dick Doster just turned in a 31-inch Bluefish.





## The Month in Review (March)



Thanks in part to cooperative weather with strong high pressure over the Gulf holding off the cold fronts, and our 2-day tournament, there were more than 267 fish reported amassing over 18,100 points for larger fish. The FOM – Spanish Mackerel – proved to be a cooperative species bending the rods of male and female anglers alike with 47 catches reported by 33 anglers. Numerous seatrout were reported with 63 fish reported by 31 anglers. Red grouper continued to cooperate offshore with 20 anglers accounting for 35 catches and 4900 points. Two of our anglers achieved TWO levels on their LOA in the same month: Rick Brown – Gold & Snook Pins & Julie Kale – Snook & Redfish Pins. There were 20 new names in the MAT with larger fish being reported. Congratulations to Rich Brennan who earned GMA Star #7 and to Fred De Mella and Cindi Johnston who proudly achieved their GMA status as a part of the 21 anglers who achieved a new rung on the LOA. Two more anglers, Randy Douet, and Jude Panetta earned their next GMA Star. Joe Udwari has already achieved 3000 points in the first 3 months of this season

## PUNTA GORDA ISLES MARINE WATCH HELP US TO HELP YOU



#### What is Punta Gorda Isles Marine Watch ("PGI Marine Watch")?

PGI Marine Watch is a volunteer on-the-water and land surveillance program like no other in Southwest Florida. The program was founded over ten years ago by Bill Guenther, a PGI resident, when he identified a need for increased security in the canals because of the increasing number of homes being built and residents moving to Punta Gorda Isles. Our group works in conjunction with the Punta Gorda Police Department, as a watch and report program. We act as a deterrent to those individuals who may be considering the theft of a boat or other



marine equipment, as well as illegal netting activity. Since its inception in 2009, the PGI Marine Watch has been an active part of reducing marine crime in Punta Gorda Isles.




#### What do our members do?

The volunteer members of the PGI Marine Watch use their own boats to patrol once a month for a two hour period. Some of our members partner with another PGI Marine Watch member and complete their patrol together, alternating boats. Some of our members patrol with a friend or their spouse. The patrol dates are flexible to fit your schedule and once your patrol is complete you email your report for the program records.

#### What is required to volunteer with the PGI Marine Watch?

The only requirement to volunteer with the PGI Marine Watch is a desire to help your community. The PGI Marine Watch program provides you with signage for your boat and works with you to determine which patrol area works best for you based upon where you reside. The preferred boat size is at least 19 feet in length due to the occasional rough waters in Charlotte Harbor, with either a T-top or bow rail to display the "PGI Marine Watch" sign. Our PGI Marine Watch volunteers also are authorized to receive a 5% fuel discount at Fisherman's Village Marine.




