
Everyone please stay safe. We will be through this mess soon enough.

PUNTA GORDA ISLES FISHING CLUB RANDY'S FISHING REPORT

Our "Spring Fling" is still going well! Lots of photos for all three categories. Keep it up. And if you haven't entered anything yet, get out there!

May is COBIA MONTH. I'm not the best cobia guy in the club but I have managed to catch several. A great bait for them is live shrimp rigged on a red Rockport Rattler jig head. Some of us have had success using hard silver twitch baits. Four spots to try are the North end of the Southbound 41 bridge area. Second is the area near and under Harpoon Harry's (early morning). Third is the south end of Alligator Reef. The fourth is near Mangrove Point. These are powerful fish. Don't flip them in green...they have damaged boats, tackle, and fishermen! Legal limit is one fish. 33" TO THE FORK is minimum length. With the harbor water so clear now, you may be able to see them. They often swim in pairs or threes. As I've said before, they like to "nose" your bait without striking. If you notice this, jerk it away and recast to the same spot...the second time the cobia may instinctively strike at it without playing around. Unlike snook, trout, and reds, you can keep a cobia. They are EXCELLENT table fare.

Harbor water is hovering at 80 degrees and clear. Many good reports of trout on the east wall, especially around Pirate's Harbor and Two-Pines. Turtle Bay is producing trout also, but it's seeing heavy fishing pressure.

Hopefully get to visit with y'all at our June meeting.

FISHING EVENTS SPRING FLING STATUS

As of early May, 57 members have submitted entries for the Spring Fling Event. This event is already a success, given the guidelines for social distancing in Florida. Catching three of our 29 species and earning points for larger fish are things we do on a normal basis. The Scavenging for Bait Event was selected as a different twist on our regular focus – and to just have fun. The LIVE bait requirement left out the DOA Shrimp, paddle tails, and other artificial baits. While almost all entries have been for finfish baits, we do have a few for pass crabs and fiddler crabs. We will gladly accept creative entries.

With about one week left to participate in the Spring Fling, we are considering adding additional awards for the drawings based on the level of participation. So, get out, have fun, and your catches will automatically be entered for the three events.

Appearance

Also known as ling or lemonfish.

- Long, slim fish with a broad, depressed head
- Brown in color, fading to a whitish belly
- · Dark lateral stripe extending through eye to tail
- · Lower jaw projects past upper jaw
- Young have alternating black and white horizontal stripes

Similar Species: Remora, E. naucrates (sucker disk present on top of head)

Size: Up to 6 feet (150 pounds); common from 10 to 50 pounds





The Month in Review (April)



Social distance fishing provided much relief to our stay-at-home orders during the Pandemic. There were more than 227 fish reported amassing over 13,000 points for larger fish. The FOM – Snook – proved to be more elusive, bending the rods of male and female anglers alike with 16 catches reported by 11 anglers. Red grouper continued to dominate our offshore species accounting for 44 catches by 17 anglers and amassing over 5800 points. Far less Spanish mackerel and seatrout were caught this month compared to last month. Five of our anglers achieved their Gold Pins on the LOA. Two more anglers achieved their next GMA Stars: Bobby Bretts and Dennis Krausman. Richy Kale set a new club record for cobia and now leads the Isles Trophy for men. There were 9 changes in the MAT and 5 new Club Hats were earned by those recently entering the LOA. Doug Arnold achieved both Gold and Snook Pins in the same month.

What is Punta Gorda Isles Marine Watch ("PGI Marine Watch")?

PGI Marine Watch is a volunteer on-the-water and land surveillance program like no other in Southwest Florida. The program was founded over ten years ago by Bill Guenther, a PGI resident, when he identified a need for increased security in the canals because of the increasing number of homes being built and residents moving to Punta Gorda Isles. Our group works in conjunction with the Punta Gorda Police Department, as a watch and report program. We act as a deterrent to those individuals who may be considering the theft of a boat or other



marine equipment, as well as illegal netting activity. Since its inception in 2009, the PGI Marine Watch has been an active part of reducing marine crime in Punta Gorda Isles.




What do our members do?

The volunteer members of the PGI Marine Watch use their own boats to patrol once a month for a two hour period. Some of our members partner with another PGI Marine Watch member and complete their patrol together, alternating boats. Some of our members patrol with a friend or their spouse. The patrol dates are flexible to fit your schedule and once your patrol is complete you email your report for the program records.

What is required to volunteer with the PGI Marine Watch?

The only requirement to volunteer with the PGI Marine Watch is a desire to help your community. The PGI Marine Watch program provides you with signage for your boat and works with you to determine which patrol area works best for you based upon where you reside. The preferred boat size is at least 19 feet in length due to the occasional rough waters in Charlotte Harbor, with either a T-top or bow rail to display the "PGI Marine Watch" sign. Our PGI Marine Watch volunteers also are authorized to receive a 5% fuel discount at Fisherman's Village Marine.




