With all of the unsettled messes involving "The Virus", we all are waking up to the news that Fishing Frank's burned down early this morning (May 24). My first thoughts are that the fishing community from Ft Myers to Sarasota will surge in to help Frank and his team out. The shock will hopefully be replaced by enthusiasm to rebuild...better than before. There is a "Go Fund Me" site already out there.

Of course, if the GoFundMe is easier, do that.

So, the May virtual tournament was a big success. Congrats to Dennis for championing us through the foggy virus months.

June is our first Jack Crevalle month. If you remember, in Dec-January we replaced flounder with Jack Crevalle. They are prolific eaters and small one's school up to corral minnows in the canals. They average 3-5 pounds but can easily be found in the 12-20-pound range. 20-pound test line is minimum if you're targeting the Jacks. They will bite on any small swimming live bait fish hooked in the back or front of its dorsal fin. Artificial bait includes plastic grubs, top water plugs, spoon, or buck tail jigs. Lures should always be retrieved quickly. If they swirl and miss, don't stop the retrieve...speed it up!

I have the best luck finding them on areas of spoil laid out from the dredging process long ago. There are about a dozen near the ICW. And often I'll chase birds hoping to find trout...and the school are Jacks instead. In general, the larger Jacks are offshore and they "shrink" in size as you go inshore in the harbor...and the little ones (1-3 pounds) are in the canals. If you've ever caught one, you know they "fight like hell". When boated, they are still powerful and chaotic...so be very careful with treble

hooks!

Fish of the Month – Jack Crevalle



- Black spot on gill and pectoral fin
- Yellow belly
- Fork tail
- Slopped forehead to the nose
- Found in the canals, harbor, rivers, and off shore
- Easy to find when they are chasing mullet or baitfish; surface of the water looks like it is boiling
- A fast retrieve works well when they are feeding
- Soft plastic lures like WildEye Swim Shad 4" works well



The Month in Review (May)



Social distance fishing continued to provide much relief to our stay-at-home orders during the Pandemic. Despite our tournaments, the nasty rainy weather for days at a time limited our trips with 141 fish reported amassing 12,100 points for larger fish. The FOM – Cobia – proved to be very elusive, bending the rods of only 9 anglers. Red grouper continued to cooperate with our offshore accounting for 17 catches. AJ's, various species of sharks, Spanish mackerel of respectable size, and more redfish catches topped our reports for the month. Our ladies are attaining new status on the LOA with Elaine Bretts earning her FOURTH GMA Star and Donnie Brennan achieved her first GMA Star. Jeff Barnhart became our 50th Grand Master Angler since the club began. There were 6 changes in the MAT and 5 changes in the Isles Trophy. 16 anglers achieved a new rung on their LOA. Joe Udwari has amassed a total of 4600 points already this season, on his way to best his 2018 total of 6600 points.



What is Punta Gorda Isles Marine Watch ("PGI Marine Watch")?

PGI Marine Watch is a volunteer on-the-water and land surveillance program like no other in Southwest Florida. The program was founded over ten years ago by Bill Guenther, a PGI resident, when he identified a need for increased security in the canals because of the increasing number of homes being built and residents moving to Punta Gorda Isles. Our group works in conjunction with the Punta Gorda Police Department, as a watch and report program. We act as a deterrent to those individuals who may be considering the theft of a boat or other



marine equipment, as well as illegal netting activity. Since its inception in 2009, the PGI Marine Watch has been an active part of reducing marine crime in Punta Gorda Isles.




What do our members do?

The volunteer members of the PGI Marine Watch use their own boats to patrol once a month for a two hour period. Some of our members partner with another PGI Marine Watch member and complete their patrol together, alternating boats. Some of our members patrol with a friend or their spouse. The patrol dates are flexible to fit your schedule and once your patrol is complete you email your report for the program records.

What is required to volunteer with the PGI Marine Watch?

The only requirement to volunteer with the PGI Marine Watch is a desire to help your community. The PGI Marine Watch program provides you with signage for your boat and works with you to determine which patrol area works best for you based upon where you reside. The preferred boat size is at least 19 feet in length due to the occasional rough waters in Charlotte Harbor, with either a T-top or bow rail to display the "PGI Marine Watch" sign. Our PGI Marine Watch volunteers also are authorized to receive a 5% fuel discount at Fisherman's Village Marine.






