



PUNTA GORDA ISLES FISHING CLUB RANDY'S FISHING REPORT

Lots of tough wind days in October but several of us were able to get out...and even a few more made it offshore. Thankfully, the fish are out there and patiently waiting for you. Canal fishing has been popular with lots of snook being caught and released. Redfish are also in the canals but not nearly as prolific as the snook. When the water temps start to cool a bit, the big black drum will be along the sea walls grinding and grunting. Towards the end of October, you should be able to sight fish them as the water clarity improves. They love dead shrimp or leftover pass crabs. Trout are doing well (if you can get out). East wall, especially the south portions are productive but the trout are more abundant in Pine Island Sound. Red paddle tail plastics under a cork are a good bet. If the water is tannic (east wall), then try white or pearl colors. If it's crowded with returning snowbirds, then you may break down and get some live shrimp to give you an edge.

November is Mangrove Snapper month. These guys are found in all four general areas: offshore, nearshore, inshore, and canals. It's one of only a few species you can target anywhere AND you can keep and eat them! Most fisherman I know, tight-line them with very small hooks and shrimp chunks. Offshore and nearshore they are usually a pleasant by-catch but you can target them next to sea walls and dock pilings as well as riprap. They are easy to filet, but they are also great fried whole.

Thanks to all those who attended and helped out at the October 10th Fishing Club Seminar. We had about 60 attendees and it marked our Club's return to indoor functions. Many attendees were new to the Club since "the Rona" arrived; and this was their first chance to experience Club indoor activities that didn't involve drinking!

Our speaker topic for the November general club meeting will be reducing barometric trauma in offshore fishing as well as general tips on proper fish handling. It'll be our last General Membership meeting of 2020, so hope to see you there.



What is Punta Gorda Isles Marine Watch ("PGI Marine Watch")?

PGI Marine Watch is a volunteer on-the-water and land surveillance program like no other in Southwest Florida. The program was founded over ten years ago by Bill Guenther, a PGI resident, when he identified a need for increased security in the canals because of the increasing number of homes being built and residents moving to Punta Gorda Isles. Our group works in conjunction with the Punta Gorda Police Department, as a watch and report program. We act as a deterrent to those individuals who may be considering the theft of a boat or other



marine equipment, as well as illegal netting activity. Since its inception in 2009, the PGI Marine Watch has been an active part of reducing marine crime in Punta Gorda Isles.




What do our members do?

The volunteer members of the PGI Marine Watch use their own boats to patrol once a month for a two hour period. Some of our members partner with another PGI Marine Watch member and complete their patrol together, alternating boats. Some of our members patrol with a friend or their spouse. The patrol dates are flexible to fit your schedule and once your patrol is complete you email your report for the program records.

What is required to volunteer with the PGI Marine Watch?

The only requirement to volunteer with the PGI Marine Watch is a desire to help your community. The PGI Marine Watch program provides you with signage for your boat and works with you to determine which patrol area works best for you based upon where you reside. The preferred boat size is at least 19 feet in length due to the occasional rough waters in Charlotte Harbor, with either a T-top or bow rail to display the "PGI Marine Watch" sign. Our PGI Marine Watch volunteers also are authorized to receive a 5% fuel discount at Fisherman's Village Marine.


