## PUNTA GORDA ISLES FISHING CLUB RANDY'S FISHING REPORT

We've had our third significant cold front on Monday (November 30th); setting us up for a good December. King Mackerel are being caught in good numbers near-shore in only 40'. Trolling for Kings will also produce a variety of "by-catch" like Bonita, Blackfin, and Jack Crevalle.

Don't overlook flounder now. It's the only time of year that our members target them. Try 2-6' of moving water on the harbor side of Cayo Costa and Gasparilla Islands. Bounce a half shrimp on a sandy bottom (I want to stress SANDY and not grassy) with a small jig head hook.

Trout have continued to impress. Club members have turned in dozens over 20", marking a successful FWC species season closure strategy. Remember, the FWC reviews whether or not to continue the closure directive in May of 2021. I'm doing well fishing trout in Pine Island Sound but they're being caught near the 41 bridge and all along the East wall...but check for grass...the storm in November messed some grass flats up. With the three cold fronts, look for trout in big numbers to return to Turtle Bay...especially in the "back" (North end).

December is Black Drum month. They are gathering in large numbers along with Sheepshead. A great outing for super windy days is to target them in the canals along heavily oystered sea walls and pilings. Those of you who are new to the area should try an old technique of scraping oysters off your sea wall and waiting an hour; then fishing for the drum with a large chunk of dead shrimp. You'll need 20-40 pound line since they take after the snook and like to rub your fishing line on oyster knife-edges. Even though they are edible, the large ones don't taste very good (and you need a chainsaw to clean them!!)

It's great to see so many of our members working hard on their Ladder of Achievement (LOA) species. Keep it up! Remember that it's allowable to utilize a Guide for LOA catches. A thumb rule to remember is that if "money" is involved (tournaments, Fish-of-the-Month, Master Angler Tournament, etc.) then paid guides are NOT allowed.

Hope to see you at our Christmas Party!




Our November fishing tournament generated much interest to both our resident and returning anglers. We had 68 fish reported by 33 anglers during the 4-day event from Nov. 13-16. While several small gag grouper made this list among the 20 reported this month, larger red grouper were reported later in the month from those able to get offshore. Nearly one half of the tournament fish were seatrout up to 22". There were more seatrout caught this month than any month since March. There were 9 redfish and 9 snook also reported during the tournament. The elusive king mackerel showed up for some of our anglers targeting them with a couple of 44" fish reported. Numerous anglers moved up a rung on their LOA. Joe Udwari has amassed a total of 5800 points this year, continuing to nail those large points fish – especially red grouper.



## PUNTA GORDA ISLES MARINE WATCH HELP US TO HELP YOU



#### What is Punta Gorda Isles Marine Watch ("PGI Marine Watch")?

PGI Marine Watch is a volunteer on-the-water and land surveillance program like no other in Southwest Florida. The program was founded over ten years ago by Bill Guenther, a PGI resident, when he identified a need for increased security in the canals because of the increasing number of homes being built and residents moving to Punta Gorda Isles. Our group works in conjunction with the Punta Gorda Police Department, as a watch and report program. We act as a deterrent to those individuals who may be considering the theft of a boat or other



marine equipment, as well as illegal netting activity. Since its inception in 2009, the PGI Marine Watch has been an active part of reducing marine crime in Punta Gorda Isles.




#### What do our members do?

The volunteer members of the PGI Marine Watch use their own boats to patrol once a month for a two hour period. Some of our members partner with another PGI Marine Watch member and complete their patrol together, alternating boats. Some of our members patrol with a friend or their spouse. The patrol dates are flexible to fit your schedule and once your patrol is complete you email your report for the program records.

#### What is required to volunteer with the PGI Marine Watch?

The only requirement to volunteer with the PGI Marine Watch is a desire to help your community. The PGI Marine Watch program provides you with signage for your boat and works with you to determine which patrol area works best for you based upon where you reside. The preferred boat size is at least 19 feet in length due to the occasional rough waters in Charlotte Harbor, with either a T-top or bow rail to display the "PGI Marine Watch" sign. Our PGI Marine Watch volunteers also are authorized to receive a 5% fuel discount at Fisherman's Village Marine.


