PUNTA GORDA ISLES FISHING CLUB RICHY'S FISHING REPORT

The wind blew heavy out of the southwest this morning of April 22, 2021, with taking 4 over the bow and only half way to the north hole. I said to Barry I hope they are still there. The 10-minute run took over 30 minutes this morning (love my Skeeter), for this was no normal Charlotte Harbor, as the Skeet nestled down in the far 1/3 of the hole we power poled down to slow our drift. Our only option was to pull danglers behind the boat, for it was too lumpy to stand and cast. Within 5 minutes we started to mark and at about the 7-minute mark the port rod buckled over hard and my partner was locked hard to a silver projectile, as the big tarpon did his best to free himself from his line with many long hard runs and head shaking jumps and the waves broke over the back of the boat, the tarpon was landed and released. We are back on our way home, all in under half an hour. You can watch the video entitled Tarpon kicked my bass (Youtube) on TarponWorld.com then click videos, this is only one of the wonderful things that happened in our harbor this April.

For as the first big tides of April come so do the spawning cownose rays and right on top of the rays are the cobia. An unexpected delight mixed right in with both those species were tripletail, big fat ones. It was 3 weeks of bliss, most out tarpon fishing in north or middle hole caught enough cobia to fill their freezers, Julie and I also did the same. As the rays finished spawning the cobia set up on the reefs and walls and the tripletail were gone.

The silver kings left the holes and have been in two pines for about 2 weeks now heavy. The only way I have been able to catch them has been on live threadies and they are hitting them good. We were 1 for 2 today and a big bull shark this second day of May.

The inshore fishing has just been out of sight, the trout, red and snook pics I have been getting are just great, keep it up ladies and gents!

Offshore has been a little hard to get to for that same southwest wind shut down most of the month but just give our offshore warriors a little crack in the weather and boy do they shine. Some of the names like Joe, Ron, Jeff, Rick, Bud, and Bob are getting very common. Great job offshore crew!

The inshore wrecks still have plenty of permit on them. Jim's got that dialed in. Great job Jim! I've caught some nice eating size snappers on greenies around the canal mouths. Try it you'll like it. Yum Yum.

I tried King Mackerel fishing with Bud and what a blast, you got to try that, easy fishing and fun.

So once again, it's getting late in the evening and Brandy needs walking. So, remember please, please, please go out and fish our wonderful and beautiful fish filled harbor. Remember it's easy, pull right when they pull left.


Tidbits



PUNTA GORDA ISLES MARINE WATCH HELP US TO HELP YOU



What is Punta Gorda Isles Marine Watch ("PGI Marine Watch")?

PGI Marine Watch is a volunteer on-the-water and land surveillance program like no other in Southwest Florida. The program was founded over ten years ago by Bill Guenther, a PGI resident, when he identified a need for increased security in the canals because of the increasing number of homes being built and residents moving to Punta Gorda Isles. Our group works in conjunction with the Punta Gorda Police Department, as a watch and report program. We act as a deterrent to those individuals who may be considering the theft of a boat or other



marine equipment, as well as illegal netting activity. Since its inception in 2009, the PGI Marine Watch has been an active part of reducing marine crime in Punta Gorda Isles.




What do our members do?

The volunteer members of the PGI Marine Watch use their own boats to patrol once a month for a two hour period. Some of our members partner with another PGI Marine Watch member and complete their patrol together, alternating boats. Some of our members patrol with a friend or their spouse. The patrol dates are flexible to fit your schedule and once your patrol is complete you email your report for the program records.

What is required to volunteer with the PGI Marine Watch?

The only requirement to volunteer with the PGI Marine Watch is a desire to help your community. The PGI Marine Watch program provides you with signage for your boat and works with you to determine which patrol area works best for you based upon where you reside. The preferred boat size is at least 19 feet in length due to the occasional rough waters in Charlotte Harbor, with either a T-top or bow rail to display the "PGI Marine Watch" sign. Our PGI Marine Watch volunteers also are authorized to receive a 5% fuel discount at Fisherman's Village Marine.






