It was really early this last day of May 2021, even for us after chasing the silver king in and around the pass the day before we had decided cobia was the fish of the day. Jack plate down, trim down, throttle pushed forward, the 23 Skeeter jumped up on plane banked to the port. Next stop Alligator reef, with 1 1/2 hours till dawn and a twelve-minute ride we would have good dark time to fish. After throwing my favorite jig and swim bait combo for about five minutes a switch to a six-inch swim bait, fished rather slowly, found its home in the jaws of a very nice cobia. With him in the box, it seemed instant when Barry said I'm in. After several hard pulling head shaking runs. The big hook sank home.

Now with two in the box and not light yet, we decided to leave the reef and head to the Myakka River markers. We finished that day with six cobia, only two keepers but fun! From the many cobia pics, I saw this month I have to say kudos to the girls. You rock girls!

Inshore fishing was very different for me than most May's have been. I think with the lack of rain the salt line stayed well up into the upper harbor and the fish reacted more like April then May but once that was figured out it was game on. For it was snook in the morning and cobia in the afternoon, who can complain.

With the tarpon moving out toward the pass and grouping for spawn we had some great days on the hill and the pass.

Trout fishing is no longer closed as of June 1st. Let's hope the new bag limits reduces the kill rate and preserves the species, for they are fun.

Redfish again are on both walls and big time in the rivers. Spanish Mackerels are still all the way up to the 41 bridges as we speak and there is bait everywhere.

Offshore again has been great, with many beautiful pics from the gang. Great job! Red snapper season is open. Yeah, let's go stick them.

So once again it's getting late and Brandy needs her walk, so please go out and enjoy our beautiful fish filled harbor and remember it's easy, pull right when they pull left.






**Tidbits**



# PUNTA GORDA ISLES MARINE WATCH HELP US TO HELP YOU



#### What is Punta Gorda Isles Marine Watch ("PGI Marine Watch")?

PGI Marine Watch is a volunteer on-the-water and land surveillance program like no other in Southwest Florida. The program was founded over ten years ago by Bill Guenther, a PGI resident, when he identified a need for increased security in the canals because of the increasing number of homes being built and residents moving to Punta Gorda Isles. Our group works in conjunction with the Punta Gorda Police Department, as a watch and report program. We act as a deterrent to those individuals who may be considering the theft of a boat or other



marine equipment, as well as illegal netting activity. Since its inception in 2009, the PGI Marine Watch has been an active part of reducing marine crime in Punta Gorda Isles.




#### What do our members do?

The volunteer members of the PGI Marine Watch use their own boats to patrol once a month for a two hour period. Some of our members partner with another PGI Marine Watch member and complete their patrol together, alternating boats. Some of our members patrol with a friend or their spouse. The patrol dates are flexible to fit your schedule and once your patrol is complete you email your report for the program records.

#### What is required to volunteer with the PGI Marine Watch?

The only requirement to volunteer with the PGI Marine Watch is a desire to help your community. The PGI Marine Watch program provides you with signage for your boat and works with you to determine which patrol area works best for you based upon where you reside. The preferred boat size is at least 19 feet in length due to the occasional rough waters in Charlotte Harbor, with either a T-top or bow rail to display the "PGI Marine Watch" sign. Our PGI Marine Watch volunteers also are authorized to receive a 5% fuel discount at Fisherman's Village Marine.




