To whom it may concern of the PGI fishing club,

My name is Abrianna Sadler and I work for FDEPs Charlotte Harbor Aquatic Preserves. In 2019 our office received a National Fish and Wildlife Foundation Fishing for Energy grant that allowed staff to facilitate the assessment, removal and monitoring of derelict fishing gear on four artificial reefs in the Charlotte Harbor (Cape Haze, Danger, Charlotte Harbor and Old Tire Reefs). We recently completed the 1-year post removal monitoring and developed a Story Map which summarizes the project and provides links to an educational video developed as part of the grant as well as additional information and websites (please see link to story map below). We know the artificial reefs in Lee and Charlotte County are popular fishing locations. I was contacting you to see if it would be possible to have the story map and/or story map link somewhere on your webpage or included in your next newsletter to reach the members of your organization?

It was Saturday the 26th of June, and it was well before the rooster crowed. The sky was bright for the big moon of 2 days ago, still lit up the night sky even at not quite full strength. Even my partner and myself knew the big tides of June that the silver kings love, so do the cobia. So, with the skeeter up on plane the decision to head to 1 or 7 had to be made quick, so with the skeeter banking hard to port 1 it was. As we settled about 75 yards out, Barry jumped to the front deck, lowered the trolling motor and headed to one of the deeper piles scattered around the marker. After about 10 minutes and Barry connecting on a small cobia, we played run and gun to some of our lower harbor markers for the next hour. It was shaping up to be quite a good morning, with a quick run up into the Myakka we spotted several crabbers working their lines, we looked at each other and said we're in! (For crabbers working the crab lines are cobia magnets, think about it, it's like 100 little chum slicks).

We ended that day in double digits. One at 40 inches to the split and one at 36, so maybe that will help you guys and gals out. Good luck.

The bait in our harbor is just phenomenal! The amount of threadies and different age groups means we should have bait all summer. The white bait is large and on the markers, the shrimp flush should be on the next moon. Lots of bait means lots of healthy fish and with that said the inshore bite is crazy good. Snook, reds, trout, snappers, and cobia, why leave this place for I think we found Mecca. LOL

The American red snapper is the fish of choice for the offshore crew. For my trip offshore for a try at them produced only red grouper but the same day Jim Hoffmann's boat did great. Nice going Jim - great job! The pics I have seen says the offshore crews know their stuff. Way to go guys!

The inshore reefs have been producing good permit, snappers, and other bottom fish and nice cuda. Go Mike.

The silver king seems to have vanished out of the harbor for the month of June and this year they left right on queue. The beaches, the pass and the IC still holds some fish but they are hard to get to bite, the pressure on them is immense. The peace river bridges and the Myakka held good size juveniles and some resident giant fish, worth a shot as July comes, so do the silver kings. So, get ready, check your knots, especially myself LOL. Retie your leaders, sharpen your Bait Buster hooks, get out early, and go check the harbor. For I'd bet dollars to donuts they're here as I write this.

As I said in my last month's article, I thought that June would shape up to be one of the best months ever. Well, I fished very hard in the harbor for 9 years now and never have I had such a great month. The fishing in the upper harbor is just world class!

So please go out and enjoy our fish filled harbor and remember pull right when they pull left. It's easy. Once again, it's getting late and Brandy needs her walk, so I must go now.




Tidbits

Even with our recent tournament, the number of fish reported this month was below last month, an indication that fewer fish are being caught due to weather or travel. We had a few more anglers reporting, thanks to the tournament, but less fish overall. Those that were able to find a small window to get offshore found a few red snapper but were finding them outside our 50-mile limit range. Only 4 red grouper were reported for the month indicating very few anglers could get out. Seatrout was our most consistently reported catch with 26 fish. Only 3 jack crevalle, our fish of the month, were reported with new member Randy Page catching the largest at 28". 3 redfish and 4 snook rounded out our top catch species.



PUNTA GORDA ISLES MARINE WATCH HELP US TO HELP YOU



What is Punta Gorda Isles Marine Watch ("PGI Marine Watch")?

PGI Marine Watch is a volunteer on-the-water and land surveillance program like no other in Southwest Florida. The program was founded over ten years ago by Bill Guenther, a PGI resident, when he identified a need for increased security in the canals because of the increasing number of homes being built and residents moving to Punta Gorda Isles. Our group works in conjunction with the Punta Gorda Police Department, as a watch and report program. We act as a deterrent to those individuals who may be considering the theft of a boat or other



marine equipment, as well as illegal netting activity. Since its inception in 2009, the PGI Marine Watch has been an active part of reducing marine crime in Punta Gorda Isles.




What do our members do?

The volunteer members of the PGI Marine Watch use their own boats to patrol once a month for a two hour period. Some of our members partner with another PGI Marine Watch member and complete their patrol together, alternating boats. Some of our members patrol with a friend or their spouse. The patrol dates are flexible to fit your schedule and once your patrol is complete you email your report for the program records.

What is required to volunteer with the PGI Marine Watch?

The only requirement to volunteer with the PGI Marine Watch is a desire to help your community. The PGI Marine Watch program provides you with signage for your boat and works with you to determine which patrol area works best for you based upon where you reside. The preferred boat size is at least 19 feet in length due to the occasional rough waters in Charlotte Harbor, with either a T-top or bow rail to display the "PGI Marine Watch" sign. Our PGI Marine Watch volunteers also are authorized to receive a 5% fuel discount at Fisherman's Village Marine.






