On October 1 Florida Fish and Wildlife reported very low to low concentrations of Karenia Brevis (Red Tide) in or offshore in Charlotte County. Some fish kills were noted.

Water temperatures are dropping which may improve the fishing. While the seatrout activity seemed to pick up a bit, we did not see the larger trout that were being caught in the recent past. Only 3 seatrout over 20" were reported. The grass flats look very healthy but often the fish weren't biting. In some cases, the most convenient time to fish was during slack tide when it is hard to get a bite. I was somewhat surprised to see the FOM results dominated by GMAs, but fortunately Jen Goodell and Nancy Pearson turned in 18" second place trout at the end of the month.

Tarpon are moving around the harbor along with some Cobia. One guide reported 8 Tarpon and 5 Cobia to the boat for his clients. Bait Busters still dominate for hooking the Tarpon, but several are using Threadfins with tremendous results. However, several recent days were not as rewarding. Even individuals who routinely catch multiple Tarpon spent several days with no bites. With jumbo shrimp, we had three rods get hit simultaneously. I'm sure two were tangled. No fish to the boat and I assume it was a shark that cut the rig off.

Cathy, Jeff and others are having the biggest Black Drum streak ever in the canals using side scan to locate the fish and casting Gulp white curly tails or TerrorEyes retrieved very, very slowly.

Offshore our major setback is the closure of Red Grouper for the remainder of 2021 and the closure of Lane Snapper starting mid-month. Some are shifting to the near shore reefs for Permit and larger Mangrove Snapper.

The best Solunar days this month are 5, 6, 7, 12, 13, 14, 19, 20, 21, 22, 26, 27, 28. The full moon occurs on the 20th. On the 20th, the Punta Gorda tide goes from low at 10:12 am to high at 4:21 pm. None of the best days are on the weekends.



The Month in Review (September)


Tidbits

Our number of reported catches significantly rose this month, thanks, in no small measure to the many black drum that were reported. A large pod of 35"+ black drum have remained in the same general area for weeks allowing more than 28 releases. Most of these fish were caught on artificals and we have never had so many caught in one month. Usually, our higher numbers of black drum are reported in December when they are the Fish of the Month. Cathy Hunt and Jeff Wilson corralled most of these monsters and shared the fun taking others out for a tussle with them. Our Fish of the Month, seatrout, also had a respectable 19 catches reported. John Fitzgerald became our 41st Grand Master Angler – congratulations! Tim Gibbons tied the all-time record for Snook set back in 2014 with a 45" beast – WOW!


Many of our members are celebrating Happy Hour at the Village Brewhouse and then setting up dinner plans every Wednesday at 5pm.

What is Punta Gorda Isles Marine Watch ("PGI Marine Watch")?

PGI Marine Watch is a volunteer on-the-water and land surveillance program like no other in Southwest Florida. The program was founded over ten years ago by Bill Guenther, a PGI resident, when he identified a need for increased security in the canals because of the increasing number of homes being built and residents moving to Punta Gorda Isles. Our group works in conjunction with the Punta Gorda Police Department, as a watch and report program. We act as a deterrent to those individuals who may be considering the theft of a boat or other



marine equipment, as well as illegal netting activity. Since its inception in 2009, the PGI Marine Watch has been an active part of reducing marine crime in Punta Gorda Isles.




What do our members do?

The volunteer members of the PGI Marine Watch use their own boats to patrol once a month for a two hour period. Some of our members partner with another PGI Marine Watch member and complete their patrol together, alternating boats. Some of our members patrol with a friend or their spouse. The patrol dates are flexible to fit your schedule and once your patrol is complete you email your report for the program records.

What is required to volunteer with the PGI Marine Watch?

The only requirement to volunteer with the PGI Marine Watch is a desire to help your community. The PGI Marine Watch program provides you with signage for your boat and works with you to determine which patrol area works best for you based upon where you reside. The preferred boat size is at least 19 feet in length due to the occasional rough waters in Charlotte Harbor, with either a T-top or bow rail to display the "PGI Marine Watch" sign. Our PGI Marine Watch volunteers also are authorized to receive a 5% fuel discount at Fisherman's Village Marine.


