The coming few months are the best of the year for fishing! Water is cooling off (still 80 degrees!) and the clarity in the harbor is returning. This week's "Red Tide" report, for the first time in months, declared Charlotte County waters as red-tide-free. That may change, but it's still welcome news. Our Club is seeing a huge increase in fishing photos; well above the August and September levels. 76 photos turned in by 32 different anglers with a return to more diverse species. Besides snook, trout, and black drum, we're seeing lots of cobia, redfish, and late season tarpon. I've even caught several nice bluefish (NOT nice by New Jersey and New York standards!).

Couple of FWC notes: Most of our offshore anglers know, but there will be no fall Red Snapper season this year since the annual bag quota was met in late July already. And sad news for our Club Hogfish expert, Paul Whiting; the Keys' Hogfish season closed November 1st.

Our final General Meeting of the year occurs Tuesday night, November 9th. I'll send out a reminder but at that meeting you get the opportunity to vote for your 2022 Club leadership. We had a great turnout for the October meeting to watch Bill Guenther receive the Club's first-ever Honorary Grand Master Angler award. The food drive was also a huge success. I received a very heartfelt thank-you letter from St. Vincent DePaul food pantry thanking you for helping out at a critical time. Special thanks to Cheryl Panetta for organizing it. Great turnout at our October picnic with over 70 attendees. Good to see the fellowship and fun returning after a long Corona pause.

Don't forget to register for our annual Christmas Party. It's scheduled for December 16th at the Isles Yacht Club. Get signed up at the November 9th meeting.

PUNTA GORDA ISLES FISHING CLUB VP'S FISHING REPORT

November is bringing the water temperatures a little lower which should be a positive impact on the fishing results.

For starters, make sure you have the right gear. Not just the rods, reels, line, and bait – live or artificial. There are two Apps for your phone that should be considered essential.

The Fish Rules App, http://www.fishrulesapp.com will provide the FWC rules where you are located. It works offshore also, using your phone's GPS to determine location. This is also useful for on-the-spot fish identification without needing a connection to the internet. FREE.

Additionally, the Navionics Boating App provides depth contours with 1 foot resolution enabling you to analyze bottom structure to locate the best fishing spots. I use the Sonar Mode in the App. There is a **FREE** version but I opt for the \$15-19/ year version for some really nice features.

The Navionics image shows my spots outside of Pineland in Pine Island Sound. At the Club meeting I will address why I have so many spots marked in a relatively small

area.

Fishing Conditions

Red Tide. The FWC report at the end of October cited 4 observations offshore of Charlotte County with background to medium concentrations with no fish kills noted.

Water Temperature. The water temperature is slipping below 80 degrees which will bring changes to our fishing. Perhaps most exciting is the migration of King Mackerel down the coast. We definitely have not been catching our share of this sportfish within the Fishing Club. The King Mackerel can be targeted within 5-15 miles of the coast, particularly around near shore reefs like Power Pole, Helens, Mary's, and Trembly.

Also, as the temperature drops the baitfish will not be as abundant. At that point our target species are more responsive to crustaceans instead of finfish. Fortunately, the local supply of live shrimp is best during the cooler months.

The Tripletail catch has been reported as pretty good both on the near shore buoys and within Charlotte Harbor/Gasparilla.

Cobia have been caught from the upper harbor down to Matlacha using Bait Busters, whole Ladyfish, and jumbo shrimp.

The Trout are being reported in larger sizes with a number at 22" and 23", getting closer to Bob Brett's 25" top trout for 2021.

The November Fish of the Month is Mangrove Snapper. They are available just about everywhere, but larger ones may be found on the near shore reefs, particularly if you use some chum.

The December Fish of the Month is Black Drum. Cathy and Jeff sure accounted for the largest quantity reported in years. They may not be schooled quite as tight as what they found but there are plenty around the canal docks.

And, while you are scouting out the Black Drum, note the presence of Sheepshead, which is the January Fish of the Month. The bonus is that larger Sheepshead qualify for points toward Ladder of Achievement awards.


Tidbits



PUNTA GORDA ISLES MARINE WATCH HELP US TO HELP YOU



What is Punta Gorda Isles Marine Watch ("PGI Marine Watch")?

PGI Marine Watch is a volunteer on-the-water and land surveillance program like no other in Southwest Florida. The program was founded over ten years ago by Bill Guenther, a PGI resident, when he identified a need for increased security in the canals because of the increasing number of homes being built and residents moving to Punta Gorda Isles. Our group works in conjunction with the Punta Gorda Police Department, as a watch and report program. We act as a deterrent to those individuals who may be considering the theft of a boat or other



marine equipment, as well as illegal netting activity. Since its inception in 2009, the PGI Marine Watch has been an active part of reducing marine crime in Punta Gorda Isles.




What do our members do?

The volunteer members of the PGI Marine Watch use their own boats to patrol once a month for a two hour period. Some of our members partner with another PGI Marine Watch member and complete their patrol together, alternating boats. Some of our members patrol with a friend or their spouse. The patrol dates are flexible to fit your schedule and once your patrol is complete you email your report for the program records.

What is required to volunteer with the PGI Marine Watch?

The only requirement to volunteer with the PGI Marine Watch is a desire to help your community. The PGI Marine Watch program provides you with signage for your boat and works with you to determine which patrol area works best for you based upon where you reside. The preferred boat size is at least 19 feet in length due to the occasional rough waters in Charlotte Harbor, with either a T-top or bow rail to display the "PGI Marine Watch" sign. Our PGI Marine Watch volunteers also are authorized to receive a 5% fuel discount at Fisherman's Village Marine.
