



Changes to the Ladder of Achievement:

Updates Effective January 1, 2022

- Add Black Drum to the "Points" list
 similar to AJ, Cobia,
- 2. Points for Black Drum would be 32" = 100 Points

40" = 200 Points

46" = 300 Points

3. Modify Point Values for Spotted Seatrout as follows:

18" = 100 Points no change

21" = 200 Points (now 22")

24" = 300 Points (now 25")

- Only one 300 point per year for the last several years
- 4. Eliminate Croaker from the list of approved species
 - Only six in last 4 years
- 5. Add Pinfish (an equivalent level baitfish) all sizes
- 6. These updates are not retroactive as this is an ongoing program subject to updates as fishing conditions, water quality, landings and closures may take place from time to time.

Fishing Conditions

December is our month for Black Drum as the Fish of the Month. While there was tremendous success earlier when the Black Drum were in several notable schools visited daily by Cathy and Jeff, for December we will find them more isolated in smaller groups. The canals will continue to be most productive for Black Drum.

When searching for Black Drum, note locations for Sheepshead which is the January Fish of the Month. Current reports include Snook, Redfish, and Mangrove Snapper. Occasionally, Cobia is still being caught in the harbor. Larger Spotted Seatrout is evident with Bob Bretts' 25" plus, a four-way tie for 2nd Place at 23", and a seven-way tie for 3rd Place at 22". Wow!

Flounder are on their Fall migration from the harbor and tributaries toward the Gulf. Catches of multiple Flounder are being reported at passes and along the beaches leading to the Gulf. Sixteen inch and larger Flounder make a nice meal. Since this species is usually caught as a by-catch when fishing for other species, this is a time when they can be specifically targeted in shallower water leading to the Gulf. The next shot will be during the Spring migration back into the harbor.

Offshore, the closure for Red Grouper and Lane Snapper has reduced the motivation to travel to greater depth. Some are targeting Gag Grouper and larger Mangrove Snapper in the passes and near-shore reefs.

At the last meeting, I talked about analyzing spots and noted that coordinates alone will not produce the results you desire. Tides, wind, temperature, and available food sources need to be considered. If I am fishing around Boca Pass or Cape Haze, I prefer to use the current data as being more important than just the time values. Of course they are related, but the water movement is what brings bait to the fish we want to catch.

Also, with the cooler temperatures, the fin fish bait becomes harder to get but the shrimp are more abundant. Fortunately, our target species also shift to whatever bait is most abundant.

Wrap up 2021 with some final nice catches and prepare for a fantastic 2022.



What is Punta Gorda Isles Marine Watch ("PGI Marine Watch")?

PGI Marine Watch is a volunteer on-the-water and land surveillance program like no other in Southwest Florida. The program was founded over ten years ago by Bill Guenther, a PGI resident, when he identified a need for increased security in the canals because of the increasing number of homes being built and residents moving to Punta Gorda Isles. Our group works in conjunction with the Punta Gorda Police Department, as a watch and report program. We act as a deterrent to those individuals who may be considering the theft of a boat or other



marine equipment, as well as illegal netting activity. Since its inception in 2009, the PGI Marine Watch has been an active part of reducing marine crime in Punta Gorda Isles.




What do our members do?

The volunteer members of the PGI Marine Watch use their own boats to patrol once a month for a two hour period. Some of our members partner with another PGI Marine Watch member and complete their patrol together, alternating boats. Some of our members patrol with a friend or their spouse. The patrol dates are flexible to fit your schedule and once your patrol is complete you email your report for the program records.

What is required to volunteer with the PGI Marine Watch?

The only requirement to volunteer with the PGI Marine Watch is a desire to help your community. The PGI Marine Watch program provides you with signage for your boat and works with you to determine which patrol area works best for you based upon where you reside. The preferred boat size is at least 19 feet in length due to the occasional rough waters in Charlotte Harbor, with either a T-top or bow rail to display the "PGI Marine Watch" sign. Our PGI Marine Watch volunteers also are authorized to receive a 5% fuel discount at Fisherman's Village Marine.




