Hello again! The frigid weather and windy conditions calmed down a bit, allowing many of us to get offshore finally. Gauging by photos and several conversations, it looks like the fishing has been good. Sea fog and cool morning runs make it interesting. Inshore remains good for snook, cobia, and small tarpon. Redfish are a bit slower than recently, but the trout have had a significant decline. I believe it to be grass health. Some flats that only two months ago were teaming with turtle grass is now either barren or covered with "stink grass". You can still find decent grass though...and to increase your odds, you should run north or south (Placida or south Pine Island Sound). I found a few trout in pools of 2.5' of water within large expanses of 12" water south of Two-Pines. This is generally the southern end of the east wall where the coast bends southwards to form Matlacha Bay. If you can get in there, you can have a blast but there are lots of boats, even midweek.

Our first 12-day tournament ended up a success. I want to thank Mike Dougherty, our fishing events director, for adding the five perfect weather days onto the end of the original 5 windy and cold days! We'll reward the winners at our March 8th General Meeting.

Rumors are floating that the FWC will open snook and redfish on June 1st but stay tuned. Many of our members think that they should keep the closed directive in place longer, and many think they should re-close trout, too. One of the best ways to help pool our voices is to join and support the CCA. And a great way to support the CCA is to attend the CCA Banquet on March 24th. 



PUNTA GORDA ISLES FISHING CLUB VP'S FISHING REPORT

The Fish of the Month is **Spanish Mackerel**.

Vice President: Dennis Krausman





Appearance:

- Back is bluish-green, fading to silvery sides and belly
- Irregular golden-yellow spots on sides
- Bluish-black blotch on front of first dorsal fin
- Lateral line slopes gently from behind the gill cover to the tail

Similar Species:

• King Mackerel lateral line drops sharply below the second dorsal fin

Fishing tips:

Spanish Mackerel are aggressive feeders that will strike a wide variety of natural and artificial baits. Trolling or watching for birds can be a very productive strategy for catching Spanish Mackerel.

While grass habitat has been difficult to find in Charlotte Harbor, the recent catches of trout greater than 18 inches indicate the fish are still present. Cobia have continued to be caught, although most seem to be 1-2 inches short of the 33" legal size.

Large Tarpon have also returned to the Harbor. Bait Busters and live ladyfish have been very effective.

Several Pompano have been reported near the East Wall.

Offshore Grouper action is improving. Bait, which has been scarce, seems to have returned with great availability around 40-50 foot depths. The size of fish caught has also improved, whereby 25-33 inch Grouper are more common.




The Month in Review (February 2022)_{Record Keeper: Paul Whiting}



Tidbits

Our Fish of the Month, Grouper, cooperated nicely for those who could find a window of decent weather to get offshore with 23 reported catches. This bodes well for the future months. Twice as many anglers turned in twice as many fish as in January, owing in no small part to our Valentines Tournament that was extended to give more fishable days due to bad weather at the beginning of the contest. AJ's began to cooperate offshore as well and Mike White and Christine were out there in the harbor boating several fish in the 35"+ range with a 41 incher the largest to date. Mike was also the first angler to achieve a GMA Star (his 4th) this year. Sheepshead continued to cooperate as well with several reported catches in the 16" and up range. Large Spanish Mackerel also appeared with fish up to 24" reported.



PUNTA GORDA ISLES MARINE WATCH HELP US TO HELP YOU



What is Punta Gorda Isles Marine Watch ("PGI Marine Watch")?

PGI Marine Watch is a volunteer on-the-water and land surveillance program like no other in Southwest Florida. The program was founded over ten years ago by Bill Guenther, a PGI resident, when he identified a need for increased security in the canals because of the increasing number of homes being built and residents moving to Punta Gorda Isles. Our group works in conjunction with the Punta Gorda Police Department, as a watch and report program. We act as a deterrent to those individuals who may be considering the theft of a boat or other



marine equipment, as well as illegal netting activity. Since its inception in 2009, the PGI Marine Watch has been an active part of reducing marine crime in Punta Gorda Isles.




What do our members do?

The volunteer members of the PGI Marine Watch use their own boats to patrol once a month for a two hour period. Some of our members partner with another PGI Marine Watch member and complete their patrol together, alternating boats. Some of our members patrol with a friend or their spouse. The patrol dates are flexible to fit your schedule and once your patrol is complete you email your report for the program records.

What is required to volunteer with the PGI Marine Watch?

The only requirement to volunteer with the PGI Marine Watch is a desire to help your community. The PGI Marine Watch program provides you with signage for your boat and works with you to determine which patrol area works best for you based upon where you reside. The preferred boat size is at least 19 feet in length due to the occasional rough waters in Charlotte Harbor, with either a T-top or bow rail to display the "PGI Marine Watch" sign. Our PGI Marine Watch volunteers also are authorized to receive a 5% fuel discount at Fisherman's Village Marine.
