# PUNTA GORDA ISLES FISHING CLUB VP'S FISHING REPORT

There are several potential areas where our Fishing Club may be able to contribute to efforts for improving the Charlotte Harbor fishery.

I have been representing PGIFC at the Costal and Heartland National Estuary Program (CHNEP), where we are developing plans to evaluate the salt ponds which are part of the habitat for Snook and Tarpon until they can survive in open water. Initial evaluations in the Cape Haze area establish some procedures for evaluations along the East Wall. Since the East Wall is one of our most accessible areas for Snook and Redfish, we are particularly interested in how PGICA members can assist in this assessment.

Several outcomes from the last CHNEP workshop led to probable roles working with the FWC and local groups addressing Charlotte Harbor issues.

We have some initial plans supporting an FWC Cobia Project. We will provide several Cobia carcasses to FWC for evaluation of sexual maturity during the Cobia spawning season. Additionally, within several weeks we will take FWC personnel out to tag Cobia. This collaboration is expected to last for 2022 and 2023.

Several members will be supporting the University of Florida Sea Grant Program for Eyes on Seagrass. We will survey multiple locations in Charlotte Harbor during May and July to identify types of seagrass present, % of cover in a half-meter grid, types of algae present, and collection of soil samples. We have also recruited several Charlotte County High School students to participate.

Charlotte County created a new position for Harbor Water Quality Management. The manager is also part of the CHNEP workshops that I participate in. He is interested in community support in evaluating and monitoring the water quality, particularly along the East Wall. Currently, the Charlotte Harbor Estuary Management office has a monitoring site near Alligator Creek and another near Pirate Harbor, but they have no visibility on what is happening on the East Wall in between.

While these initiatives are focused on data collection for research, the CHNEP Workshops are specifically addressing how to connect the research and the decision makers early in the process to initiate corrective action on a shorter time scale.



### **Appearance**



COBIA (Rachycentron canadum)

Also known as ling or lemonfish.

- · Long, slim fish with a broad, depressed head
- Brown in color, fading to a whitish belly
- Dark lateral stripe extending through eye to tail
- Lower jaw projects past upper jaw
- Young have alternating black and white horizontal stripes

State Record: 130 lb 1 oz, caught near Destin

Men's Club Record: Richy Kale, 56", 2021

Ladies' Club Record: Joanne Landaker, 2008, Marilyn McGregor, 2013, 50"

Legal size limit for Cobia changes to 36" Fork Length on July 1, 2022. Currently, 33" fork length is eligible for keeping fish and count for LOA species.

Fishin' Frank will be the Guest Speaker for May and will share information on techniques for catching Cobia.


### The Month in Review (April 2022)

Our Fish of the Month, Snook, were in limited supply with only 6 anglers reporting a total of only 8 fish. Seatrout were very prolific (28), and the red grouper offshore continued to be found by those able to get there between cold fronts. A few cobia (4) were still around this month as well. Three new members earned their Club hats, and Bobby Bretts became the 3<sup>rd</sup> Master Angler to earn a GMA Star so far this year – his 7<sup>th</sup>! In the Isles Trophy race, two lady anglers reported new club records: Dianne Bukowski with a 47.5 black drum at 103.3% of the old record; Nancy Pearson did even better with a King Mackerel catch that is 105.3% of the old record. Way to go, ladies!

# PUNTA GORDA ISLES MARINE WATCH HELP US TO HELP YOU



#### What is Punta Gorda Isles Marine Watch ("PGI Marine Watch")?

PGI Marine Watch is a volunteer on-the-water and land surveillance program like no other in Southwest Florida. The program was founded over ten years ago by Bill Guenther, a PGI resident, when he identified a need for increased security in the canals because of the increasing number of homes being built and residents moving to Punta Gorda Isles. Our group works in conjunction with the Punta Gorda Police Department, as a watch and report program. We act as a deterrent to those individuals who may be considering the theft of a boat or other marine equipment, as well as illegal netting activity. Since its inception is



marine equipment, as well as illegal netting activity. Since its inception in 2009, the PGI Marine Watch has been an active part of reducing marine crime in Punta Gorda Isles.




#### What do our members do?

The volunteer members of the PGI Marine Watch use their own boats to patrol once a month for a two hour period. Some of our members partner with another PGI Marine Watch member and complete their patrol together, alternating boats. Some of our members patrol with a friend or their spouse. The patrol dates are flexible to fit your schedule and once your patrol is complete you email your report for the program records.

#### What is required to volunteer with the PGI Marine Watch?

The only requirement to volunteer with the PGI Marine Watch is a desire to help your community. The PGI Marine Watch program provides you with signage for your boat and works with you to determine which patrol area works best for you based upon where you reside. The preferred boat size is at least 19 feet in length due to the occasional rough waters in Charlotte Harbor, with either a T-top or bow rail to display the "PGI Marine Watch" sign. Our PGI Marine Watch volunteers also are authorized to receive a 5% fuel discount at Fisherman's Village Marine.
