



Tidbits

Our Fish of the Month, Seatrout, were reported by 11 anglers totaling 17 fish. Twice as many large Black Drum (34) were caught in our canals ranging from 32" to 43". The Board has approved a change for 2023 moving Black Drum to September and Seatrout to December, taking advantage of the numerous canal bruisers that frequent the canals in the summer. Six tarpon were reported by 5 different anglers. Six Master Anglers earned their GMA Star for 2022 including Rich Brennan who now has a club tying NINE GMA Stars along with Joe Udwari. Two of our fine lady anglers – Christine Fontaine and Donna Sullivan - joined this elite group of GMA Star recipients earning their first one as did Jeff Wilson. Rich Kale and Dennis Krausman both earned their fifth GMA Star. Three new members earned their club hat this month.
