During a fishing trip on October 28th, I believe that I could smell it in the back of Turtle Bay. Outside of some funky colored water, I didn't detect it anywhere else (yet). Several people asked me about eating caught fish now. Between the storm septic runoffs and red tide poking around, I am stressing catch-and-release. Even though fish are around and being caught, they are under lots of stress, which isn't good for the population. So, catch and release is more so for them and not so much of a health hazard for us.

For Halloween I had a Ghost Writer do the fishing report. Many thanks to Richy Kale for sharing his experience on the water.

It was just a tad before dawn this October 31st 2022, the sky was bright with stars & so were my expectations. For not being able to prowl our harbor like usual-this October, for a hurricane & eye surgery that took too long to heal sidelined me for the first 2 weeks. When I finally did get out, the water temperature gauge read 64 degrees; "it must be broke", I thought, but no it wasn't. I took a jerk bait, flipped it by a dock piling, twitched it & gone. A small snook inhaled it. I flipped her in & flipped her back. Repeated that scenario many times since that cast. The inshore fishing has been fantastic. Even I have been catching lots of reds along with flounder, snook, trout, snappers, lady fish & catfish. My efforts at cobia have blanked out, but with the amount of eels & skates in the harbor, it is only a matter of time. (Get the lemon ready boys & girls).

And for all but one. The silver kings have left the harbor. Of course, Rick is still catching. Kudos Rick! The juries have set up residence in their usual winter spots; lots of fun to catch. The 3t's on the traps in the gulf are still on the smaller size but they are showing up. There is cobia on the inshore wrecks. Some real good ones worth the try.

So tomorrow November comes in. At dawn, I will be on the west wall, for there are big redfish schools at the creeks' mouths. The reds are schooled up now & are running the outside of the bars at turtle & bull bays; shallower the better (forces them off the flats where even a Jersey boy can catch them. I stink shallow).

I know Randy has been trout fishing & has done very well in Pine Island area. I have caught with Joe B on mangrove point & solo all the way down the east wall (listen cobia the trout are here, come eat).

As I wrote many times in the past, November starts great canal fishing. As water temperatures start to plummet, the fish head for deeper warmer canals. So remember.... just cause it's close doesn't mean it's not good fishing.

And here is the Big One...when the cold November winds start to blow & the water temperatures struggle to get into the 60's & the harbor looks like a mogul field whipped by the wind, turn your boats east & come find me at home. Prowling the cuts & deep runs of the peace; for what swims in the harbor swims in the peace.

So once again the semi-sad eyes of my yellow tells me it's walk time. So, I must bid you so long, cause Brandy rules.

So please, please go out & cast a line in our harbor this November. You may be pleasantly surprised.





What exactly is the Punta Gorda Isles Marine Watch Program?
