- HAVE SHARP DORSAL SPINES.
- HAVE A HARD MOUTH, WITH SEVERAL ROWS OF STUBBY TEETH THE FRONTAL ONES CLOSELY RESEMBLING HUMAN TEETH WHICH HELP CRUSH THE SHELLS OF PREY.
- CAN BE CONFUSED WITH A SMALL BLACK DRUM. SHEEPSHEAD HAVE A SHARP SLOPPING NOSE. THE STRIPES ON A YOUNG BLACK DRUM ARE NOT AS PRONOUNCED.

HABITAT:

- CAN BE FOUND NEAR BARNACLES; ROCK PILINGS/STRUCTURE, JETTIES, MANGROVE ROOTS, DOCKS, SEAWALLS, AND PIERS AS WELL AS IN TIDAL CREEKS.
- CAN BE FOUND ON NEAR SHORE REEFS.
- TEND TO HEAD TO DEEPER WATER TO SPAWN IN MARCH AND APRIL BY STRUCTURE.

FISHING TIPS:

- FEED ON BIVALVES AND CRUSTACEANS. SUCCESSFUL BAITS INCLUDE SHRIMP, SAND FLEAS
 (MOLE CRABS), CLAMS, FIDDLER CRABS, AND MUSSELS.
- HAVE A KNACK FOR STEALING BAIT, A SMALL STRONG HOOK IS NECESSARY.
- THE BITE CAN SEEM TENTATIVE, PECK, PECK, PECK, THEN THE BITE. SOMETIMES SLOWLY MOVING THE BAIT A FEW INCHES AWAY WILL SECURE THE STRIKE.

The cold front in December changed this up a bit. The fish moved once again. Remember to slow it down when the water is colder.

In-shore:

If you want to bend the rod and have some fun; bonnethead sharks, sea trout, jack crevalle, and sheepshead are the best bet.

Bonnetheads – have been seen around the outside of the bars on the lower east and west walls, two pines, and cape haze; eating live shrimp or cut bait. Light spinning tackle is all you need.

Sea trout - have been around pirate harbor, turtle bay, and pine island sound. Try the deeper pot holes with the cooler water temperatures. They are taking live shrimp and soft plastics.

Sheepshead - see FOM information.

Jack Crevalle – troll a spoon or lure in the canals or along the bars. Be kind to the fish and replace treble hooks with a single hook or at a minimum crimp the barb on the treble hooks.

Fishin Franks had reports of oversized redfish being caught at 2 pines and Boca area, and a few pompano skipping the bars on the west wall.

There haven't been many recent off shore reports mainly due to the weather and red grouper/ lane snapper closure until January 1st. Hopefully members are getting back out there.


