## FISHING REPORT



I wonder if the lack of tarpon submitted for August was due to the lack of folks targeting them, catching them, and/or just not turning them in? For me personally it was just too stinking hot to target them; hopefully that changes for September.

Before hurricane Idalia came through the tarpon were finally schooling up. I'm sure they settled back into their areas shortly after the storm. Dangling DOA baitbusters using a slow controlled drift should provide a hookup. Using a ladyfish will also get a bite and increase the chances of a shark as a by-catch.

The shark bite continues to be strong using cut and live bait. Folks are catching the big ones in the deep holes, outside turtle bay/hill area, and deeper troughs.

Spadefish are plentiful around areas of structure.

Redfish have moved in and the numbers should increase in the coming weeks. Shrimp, cut bait, white bait, gold spoons, and soft plastics are all a good bet.

### Fish of the Month For SEPTEMBER Location, Description, Tips, Tackle and Bait







#### **BLACK DRUM**

#### Identification:

- Smaller black drum can be confused with sheepshead due to the whiteish coloring with black stripes. You won't be targeting the small ones this month!
- As they get larger, they lose their striping and become golden in color.
- Wide bodies, tails, and head.
- Can hear the "drum" sound.

#### Location/finding them:

- During summer months they school up in the canals, schools can have 10 to hundreds of fish.
- Pre hurricane Idalia they were in the port charlotte canals and canals by Bass Inlet; near larger open bodies of water.
- If you have good side scan and know how to use side scan; you can't miss them.
- Look for little baitfish and disturbances on the surface as well as the bottom getting mucked up.

#### Gear/tackle:

- Light gear works well: an 8 14 rod with a 3,000 spinning reel. You'll be casting a lot and making long casts.
- Soft plastics with a small strong hook (eighth ounce jig head with gulp), crab, and shrimp all work. Stay away from using larger hooks as it increases foul hooking the fish; putting undue stress/harm on the fish.
- 20-pound 3' leader and fluorocarbon.

#### <u>Technique:</u>

- They like a slow presentation. So slow that you should feel your lure over the school or on the bottom. I mean slow......
- The bite is subtle, your line will start to straighten, then the fish will realize it's hooked and make a run for it. They'll run a few times, again when they see the boat, and again when they see the net.

#### Technique:

• With the high-water temperatures, it's important to revive the fish. There are plenty of good video's out there on how to do that.

#### Miscellaneous:

- Running through a school with your engine will cause them to scatter; you'll piss off other boats. Use your trolling motor, if you don't have a trolling motor stay on the outside of the school.
- Black drum is a species for Ladder of Achievement and eligible for points.
- Master Angler Tournament currently has a 3-way tie for first place at 42".
- This is an easy, fun, and big fish to catch. Hardest part is finding the schools.

With the continuation of an extraordinary heat wave, windy weather, a near miss hurricane, and numerous out of town trips by our locals, the number of anglers out on the water continued to decline this month. Not many folks targeted our Fish of the Month, (Tarpon), preferring to catch other species. The Black Drum have continued to show up in large traveling schools in our canals and those with side scanning sonar can find these scattered schools of jumbo bruisers who seem willing to hit both artificials and live bait equally well. 30 black drum in the mostly 100 point class size (32"-41") were reported. We expect them to stay in the canals for another month and they are now our FOM in September. They are a lot of fun on light tackle but be sure to revive them in these hot water conditions before sending them back to their school. With the closing of the Red Grouper fishing from mid-July to the end of the year, not as many off-shore members have been going out. Congratulations to Donna Sullivan who became the sixth angler to earn a GMA Star, her 2nd!

### AUGUST MEETING MINUTES

<u>Guest Speaker</u>: Steven Phillips. Steve is the Owner and Operator of Southern Charm Charters, at Southerncharmcharters.com, 678-787-4750.

Steve gave a brief fishing report. Pompano are plentiful in the harbor for the last 2 weeks, using a pink silly jig or a bobber and shrimp. At the middle harbor markers, Cobia have been biting. Redfish schools are also showing up at the Burnt Store sandbar.

His presentation was about fishing for Tarpon. He said the river is usually 9 feet, but currently in a drought state, at about 3 feet. Most of the Tarpon are in the Boca Pass eating crabs. To fish for them, stay in the Tarpon Triangle. (Or near the 20 foot holes, Alligator reef and Tire reef). They are also spotted by Marker 8, near the Myakka River, The key is to cast with a bait buster, without bobbers with a slow retrieve. Chum for them with lady fish or thread fins. Also fish the bridges at night with pin fish or squirrel fish.

Steve stated that he often trolls the walls at 2.5 - 3 mph with bait busters, all the while looking for fish. Currently there are problems attracting the bull sharks. In September to October you can switch to live bait. If you don't have a trolling motor, you can drift towards the tarpon with your bait buster. A purple bait buster with a bobber is very successful. You can also use live lady fish or hard head catfish.
