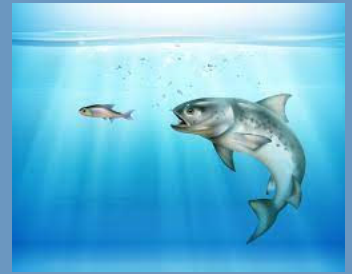


FROM THE HELM

FISHING REPORT- JUNE

It was 4:10 am on Wednesday May 24th, 2024. The moon was 24 hours after full & there was no wind for once. As the 23 Skeet slipped by the Ponce boat ramp & out between the poles, the throttle went forward, and Skeeter jumped, banked left & a rum line was set for marker #6.

By the time I hit #6 the first hint of light graced the eastern sky, as I reached my favorite marker I hoped my Triple Tails (3t's) stayed home to feed on flushing crabs. I would know real soon if my early morning jaunt was worth it for my first cast hit home, getting close enough to my target to splash the pole but not hit it. With an open bail the jig sank straight down & yes it was worth it. That cast enabled me to land my biggest 3t to date 32" long 28" round & 24 pounds. It was backed up with a 29 1/2 inch fish. WOW great morning!



Now time for Cobia. June has arrived & so have the bait. With the Cobia & 3t bite great in the month of May, this should continue all this month but remember with the heat & clean water a good fitting head lamp will help immensely (get it)!

The Snook fishing this month is the best it can get. With the moon of May the big line sliders have spawned out & are hungry. Top water or jerk baits will produce some great fish but a bucket of minnies and some 2/0 circle hooks will turn your hands into a cut up mess unhooking all those medium Snook.

The bigger-than-average Trout are here, with Alligator reef, Tire reef & Cape Haze reef being my go-to spots, the grass beds along the bars are all holding fish now. Fish a little deeper. The river is holding big schools of Black Drum up by the power lines, there are good Reds mixed in with them. The Reds are on the bars & in Turtle & Bull bay, cut crabs work well.

Near shore reefs are holding some real good Permit. Fred & myself went out & tried for them with some success. A little better net work by me would have helped the score, oh well.

Tarpon are mainly a pass & beach thing now, out to about 6 miles, crabs, Threadies & Pin Fish make up most captain's choices. I prefer a purple bait buster.

Offshore the bite has been good as for the captain I asked with Snappers from 55 ft & out. Red Grouper seem to be plentiful for some, some nice Trigger Fish also & Yellowtails. The Amber Jacks on some of the bigger wrecks have been outstanding. Shark fishing remains good. Pirate Harbor hole & Cape Haze reef area is worth trying as the Spanish Mackerel are everywhere. Troll a spoon around marker #1 to Alligator reef (bring ice).

On a real fun note, there are some big Mangrove Snappers around, again a bucket of minnies is all you need.

Note: with two shoulder injuries at the same time & needing time to heal the long runs to catch the Silver King will have to wait for mid June with that being a must. I turned my attention to the inshore fish of the harbor there are so many great fishing opportunities in the harbor that if the Silver King didn't pull so hard & jump so high I might just stay inshore. But as long as I can stand on the front of my Skeeter & there are Tarpon, that won't happen LOL!

I did not mention anything about King Mackerel this month, I think that distinction belongs to Mike White. Mike caught a world class fish this month. Give him a call. He can tell the story better than I can write it. Thumbs up to you Mike.



So once again I bid you so long until next month. For the semi sad eyes of my yellow beckon me for our evening walk. So please, please go out try our fish filled harbor & remember it's easy pull left when they pull right.

Fish of the Month For JUNE

Location, Description, Tips, Tackle and Bait

JACK CREVALLE



Gear, Tackle, Rigging, and Technique:

- Medium to light rod with a 3,000 spinning reel or whatever you have will work.
- 20-pound braid tied to 20-pound leader will get the job done. Jacks don't seem to be line shy when they are feeding. If fishing around a lot of structure you may want to go heavier.
- X-rap, spoons, Wild Eyed Storm Shads, and most other lures work when they are feeding. Always crimp the bards when using tremble hooks, or replace treble hooks with a single hook.
- A lure with some weight will increase casting distance and increase chances of a hook up. That's why I like storm shads; they are heavy and have a single hook.
- Look for "boiling water"; that signifies something is feeding on bait pods. Cast through the bait pod and **retrieve fast**. They are very aggressive when feeding.
- Trolling can also be productive.

Summer Locations:

- Look for schools of mullet, other baitfish, and birds diving.
- Troll off the sandbars and near the beaches this time of year.
- Can be found off shore, but not commonly.

Additional Information:

- **Fork length measurement.**
- Black spot on their gill and pectoral fin.
- They put up a good fight for their size.
- Not very good eating; but some people do eat them.
- Make excellent shark bait. Keep it alive and use a sinker on a shark set up outside Turtle Bay or "the hill"; you'll get great results!

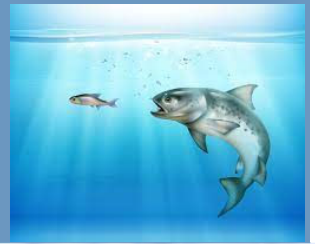

Interesting Tidbits

Our FOM, Cobia, had a reporting of 5 fish. 4 grouper were reported by those able to go offshore. Mike White found a couple of large king mackerel including a new club record 59" monster! As many of our members have gone home for the summer, our overall numbers of catches have diminished. A few reds, seatrout and snook are still being caught by those fishing the Harbor. Rick Sarkisian, one of our masters at catching tarpon, landed 4 this month and earned his 8th GMA Star! Glen Ranfos caught an unusually large 36" bluefish. Our Fish of the Month for June is Jack Crevalle which, like the species for July (Shark) and August (Tarpon) are fork length measurements or estimates. Please be aware that we need you to state your measurement for all fork length measured fish as such. While most of our seasoned anglers are aware of which fish need to be measured in this way, some of our newer anglers may not be aware of this requirement. Our club website as well as the commonly used app, **Fish Rules**, states which species require such measurement. We need ALL anglers to state the length and that these fish were measured to the fork of the tail. Something as simple as "Jack Crevalle, 22" to the fork" will suffice. Species that are measured at the fork from our list include: Amberjack, Bluefish, Cobia, Jack Crevalle, King Mackerel, Permit, Pompano, Shark (estimated at side of boat), Spanish Mackerel, and Tarpon (estimated at side of boat).

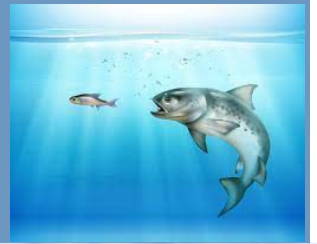
Christmas party scheduled for Wednesday, December 11
