

SHARK



Introduction to trolling for sharks

Sharks are cruising the harbor and lower rivers in the summer. They are a good species to target if you have patience and the strength to fight and land the big ones in our area. This technique focuses on trolling live ladyfish.

Identification:

They range in length and specific markings. Generally, they are all greyish in color and have very sharp teeth that sincerely want to mess you up when you hook and land one.

Locations/behavior:

- "Clean" side of tide lines; they will be taking cover and looking for bait flowing through.
- Start at marker 2 towards marker 1, stay outside the tire reef on the way to marker 1. Hang a right towards marker 7 in the Myakka River. Stay in the deeper water.
- On an out-going tide go to the west side of Alligator Reef to the west wall/marker 5 area. Stay in the deeper water and look for the tide line.
- Outside the bars on east and west wall; in 6 to 8' of water.
- Shoals by Two Pines.
- Deeper water near "the hill".
- Aggressive feeders, feed based on scent, fast swimmers.
- They will follow the scent to find the bait.
- leader too long as you need to grab the line to unhook the fish.
- Tie the leader to the barrel swivel that is on the wire leader.

SHARK, Continued

Rigging:

- Long 8' or so of leader 80 100lb; monofilament or fluorocarbon. Tie the leader to the braid.
- 1' 3' wire leader (Tooth Proof 100 lb) with a swivel at one end and a 8 12 inline circle hook to the other end. Use a haywire twist knot when making your wire leader. Don't make the wire leader too long as you need to grab the line to unhook the fish.
- Tie the leader to the barrel swivel that is on the wire leader.
- A large float (so you can see where your bait is).
- Rig the ladyfish through the nostril and lip or "bridle" through the eyes. Bridling through the eyes can yield great success as the ladyfish will not be as active when the shark is nearby and the bait won't get caught up in other lines when trolling more than 1 line.

Technique:

- This is a slow controlled troll with a trolling motor. Ideal speed is .8 mph. Can also try drifting.
- Troll against the current.
- Keep the extra live ladyfish in the livewell. The water circulating in the well goes into the water providing scent to the shark; it acts as chum.
- The bait should be ~150' behind the boat.
- The combination of the ladyfish in the livewell, going against the current, and the bait far behind the boat is key; the scent is permeating the water.
- If trolling more than 1 live bait, use extension arms if you have them to keep the baits as far away from each other as possible. Also stagger the baits at least 20' apart behind the boat; 1 bait at 140' and the other at 160'. That will reduce the fish getting tangled.
- Trolling the weed line of the tide will result in the lines getting tangled; troll the clear side. The shark tend to be on the dirty side waiting for bait to go by.

SHARK, Continued

The bite:

- Hard, strong, and get ready for the drag to peel off the reel.
- Get other rods reeled in and stowed for the fight.
- It's hard to miss a shark (or other large fish) that take your bait.

Safety:

- Release the shark as soon as possible.
- Don't boat the shark; even the small ones. A picture of the shark in the water with estimated fork length is all that is needed for Ladder of Achievements and Fish of the Month.
- Always have a good pair of protective gloves on board to grab the leader.
- Do not wrap the leader around your hand.
- Have a good pair of long handled wire/hook cutters and dehooking device.
- Always best to fish with a partner.
- Large sharks are known to get pissed after getting hooked, just ask long time club member Joe
 Udwari about the shark that bit the back of his boat after landing it. It did a number on his fiber-glass.
- Have good first-aid supplies on boat just in case; a good tourniquet at the least.

- Start with guide or experienced companion







TARPON-THEIR SAFETY

THEIR SAFETY

- > MUST revive
- › Best option for beginners is "tow and cut"
- Boat in reverse for pictures and revival
- For PGIFC submittals a picture of the fish only is acceptable
- Be aware of potential sharks when fighting or releasing
- Try and limit fight to 30 minutes or less

TARPON

TARPON FISHING BASICS

Deep hole always good

- Fish are there April to Halloween
- BGP area is best April through June but much more technical
- Harbor is best place in the state from August to Oct/Nov

Bait Buster method

- Simple and effective
- Any boat
- > Any time
- > Bobber or not

Free-lining method (best)

- Use live ladyfish
- Requires good livewell
- Messy

- Birds

TARPON

TARPON-TACKLE

- Standard "tarpon rod"
 - > 8' spinning rod
 - Shimano Teramar TMS-X80XH (\$129)
 - > 5000-10000 reel
 - Daiwa BG5000 (\$120)
 - Quantum Cabo 60 (\$200)
 - > 50 to 65# braid
 - DO NOT use less than 50#
 - > 6' of 60 or 80# fluorocarbon leader
 - Note: Your "grouper rod" will work with ladyfish or BaitBuster danglers IF it has a good drag and min 65 # braid

Knots

- Spider hitch or Bimini Twist to double the braid
- Albright, FG or Double Uni for braid to leader
- Loop knot for Bait Buster

TARPON

TARPON WITH DOA BAITBUSTER

"How to catch a tarpon from your deck boat"

Rig

- › Keep hook sharp!
- > Loop knot
- 4 to 6' leader 60 or 80 lb. fluorocarbon
- Trolling model Bait Buster in root beer, silver/black or purple
- > Lure must run true

Retrieve

- No sink or drop to bottom
- > Steady retrieve, no action
- > SLOW
- > Throw at rolling fish
- Also, dead stick (dangler) with or without bobber

· TAP!

- > Hard hook set
- > Bow to the silver king

TARPON

TARPON FREE-LINING

- Standard tarpon rod
 - 6' to 8' leader 80# fluorocarbon
 - 8/0 or 9/0 circle hook (Trokar Lancet offset CK3 or offset TK3)
- Hook live ladyfish thru mouth and nostril
 - Catch trolling in 3-5'
 - Walmart crappie jigs or small spoons
- Drift behind boat
 - > Trolling motor control best
 - One or two rods (float w/ two)
 - > 30' to 100' back
- Watch for rolling fish
- Rod in holder
 - > No free spool
 - > No hookset
 - > Bow to the silver king

TARPON

HARBOR ETIQUETTE

- Tarpon are easily "put down" by boats.
- Do not run your outboard any closer than ¼ mile from a group of boats fishing for tarpon.
- Only enter a group of boats fishing for tarpon with your trolling motor. (If you don't have a trolling motor, stay outside "the pack." Tarpon schools in the harbor are large and scattered so you don't need to be in the middle of the group.)
- Unless invited, stay 100 yards away from other boats.
- Do not block the drift of other boats.

Interesting Tidbits

With the combination of nasty, rainy weather and our normal exodus of many Club members to cooler northern climates, our FOM, Jack Crevalle, had a reporting of only 4 fish, and those were no monsters either. 5 grouper were reported by those able to go offshore including an impressive 33.5" red grouper landed by Cathy Hunt which is the largest grouper reported to date by one of our lady anglers. 5 shark catches were reported including some monster nurse sharks up to an estimated 8' in length. Our recent tournament resulted in several trout and snapper reports even though the weather forced some date changes during this competition. Black drum also are being caught in our canals and should grow in numbers the next couple of months. Our Fish of the Month for July (Shark) and August (Tarpon) are fork length estimates at boat side and the angler does NOT need to be in the photo for safety reasons. When determining the winners for July (Shark) and August (Tarpon) please remember that there will be cumulative points for multiple fish to determine the winners. According to our rules: Tarpon and shark awards will be based on the total number of points accumulated for these species caught in their respective award months: 1st place for the most points, 2nd place for the second most points and place for the third most points. Any tarpon or shark estimated to be 5 feet or longer to the fork is awarded 3 points, whereas any smaller fish will only be awarded 1 point.

A BIG congratulations to Rich Brennan for earning his 11th GMA Star – a new Club record! Bobby Bretts also earned his 9th GMA Star. So far this year, four member GMAs have earned a Star with another $\frac{1}{2}$ year to go for the rest of the GMA Star seekers.


