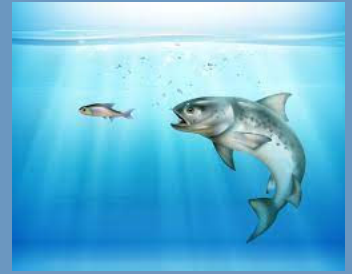

FISHING REPORT For NOVEMBER

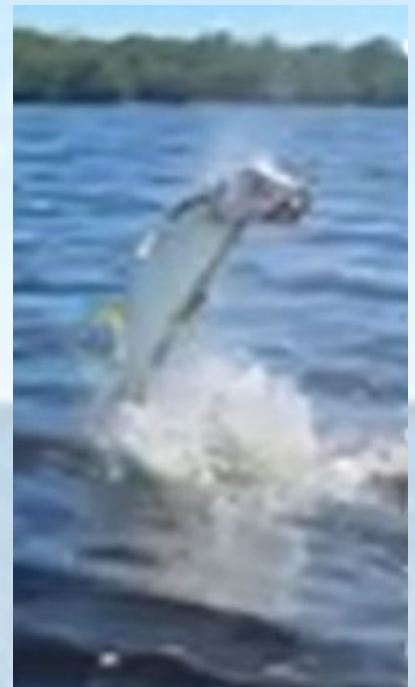

It was Sunday dec 1st 2024 moon phase, new moon; time 645 am. The gate to my back yard swung open and a 'good morning Richy' came out of the dark. It was my friend and guest for the day Joey B, and our targeted species for the day were, what else but Tarpon. Air temp was 38 degrees, water temp was 64.7, and wind 15/20 out of the north. Just perfect weather for Tarpon, I chuckled, 'hope you have enough clothes' I said and Joes answer was 'yup I do'. So without further ado the 250 fired up and a slight push off the dock started the day. As we passed the red and green poles of Ponce Park , I throttled down the Skeeter and jumped a bank to the right. As we slid under the 75 bridge Joey managed a smile though the cold morning air, for at that point he knew where I was heading. After a little wiggle and a couple of waggles, jack plate up and down a couple of times, the Skeeter came off plane and slid up to the first of many points to be explored that day. With a cast and drag method in use, it wasn't long before Joes Reaper rig buckled under the weight of a nice Tarpon. Silver skyward, Joey's smile, my day was made. That was one of 15 hookups that morning . Wow love that winter Tarpon - just don't glance down at the temp lol.

And now for Redfish, what I can say is before the cold snap the upper harbor had a good number of Reds to be caught on jigs and spoons. I was very shallow, for my Skeeter bumped a lot.

Snook fishing is a canal thing now with jerkbaits and swim-Shad's doing the trick. Look for snook lights on the docks, for they don't move much.

Trout fishing is very productive right now with fish holding on the east wall reef and above the 41 bridge . If it's windy, sneak up Alligator Creek, for it holds all 3 species in good numbers. Just remember to bring your paddle up the creek lol.

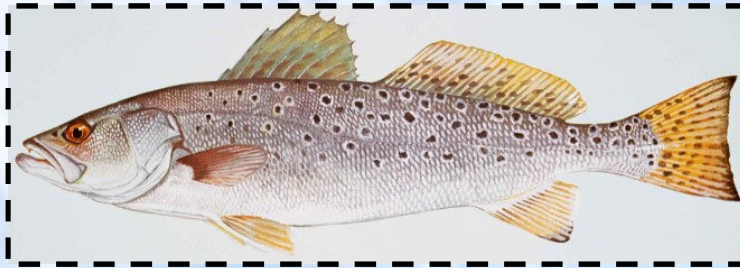

Fish of the Month For DECEMBER

Location, Description, Tips, Tackle and Bait

SPOTTED SEA TROUT



Gear/tackle:

- *Light spinning rod and reel; 10 – 15 lb braid.*
- *Poppin cork tied to braid and other end to ~2.5 - ~3' of 15 lb fluorocarbon.*
- *Soft plastic on a jig head, DOA shrimp, vudu shrimp. Cut bait works and tends to catch larger, but fewer fish. Of course, live shrimp works great too and chances of hooking a shark increases.*
- *Use a strong soft plastic, puffer fish will often bite the tail off.*

Locations:

- *Tend to be in ~3' of water; likely deeper as water temperature drops. Entrance into Pirate Harbor, in Turtle/Bull bays, Pine Island sound, docks at the Elks club, and upriver near the mangroves.*
- *Look for healthy grass near deeper pockets of water and sandbars. Many times, you'll get a strike right at the edge of the sandbar.*

Technique:

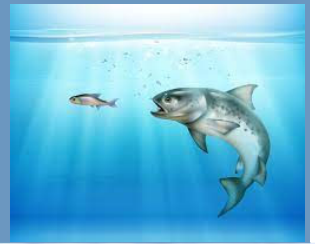
- *Pop the cork to make sound and push the water – that gets their attention and raises the bait above the grass.*
- *Vary the amount of popping of the cork.*
- *Watch for the bobber to go down and set the hook*

Interesting Tidbits

Now that more members have completed repairs to their dwellings and docks, some are finding time to get out on the water. The normal inshore species one might expect this time of year did not disappoint: seatrout (including a couple of 22" fish caught by Bobby Bretts and Gary Selzer), mangrove snapper (including a 22" monster caught by Fred De Mella), redfish (including a nice 31" red caught by Rick Brown), jack crevalle (including a 28" hard fighting jack caught by Tony Nowicki), and sheepshead just now beginning to show up. Congratulations to Greg Selzer who earned his Snook Pin this month. As the water cools the fish are becoming more active, so get out this month and chase those big "gator" seatrout which are our FOM for December. If you find a window to get offshore, Gov de Santis has opened some more recreational fishing dates to harvest red snapper (see our Facebook page for specifics on these dates). Be aware, NOAA has just CLOSED the lane snapper fishery in Federal waters (beyond the 9-mile limit of State waters) until Jan. 1, 2025; red grouper is CLOSED until January, 2025; gag grouper remains closed in Federal waters until September, 2025.

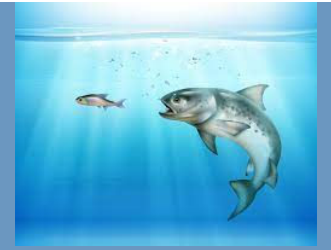

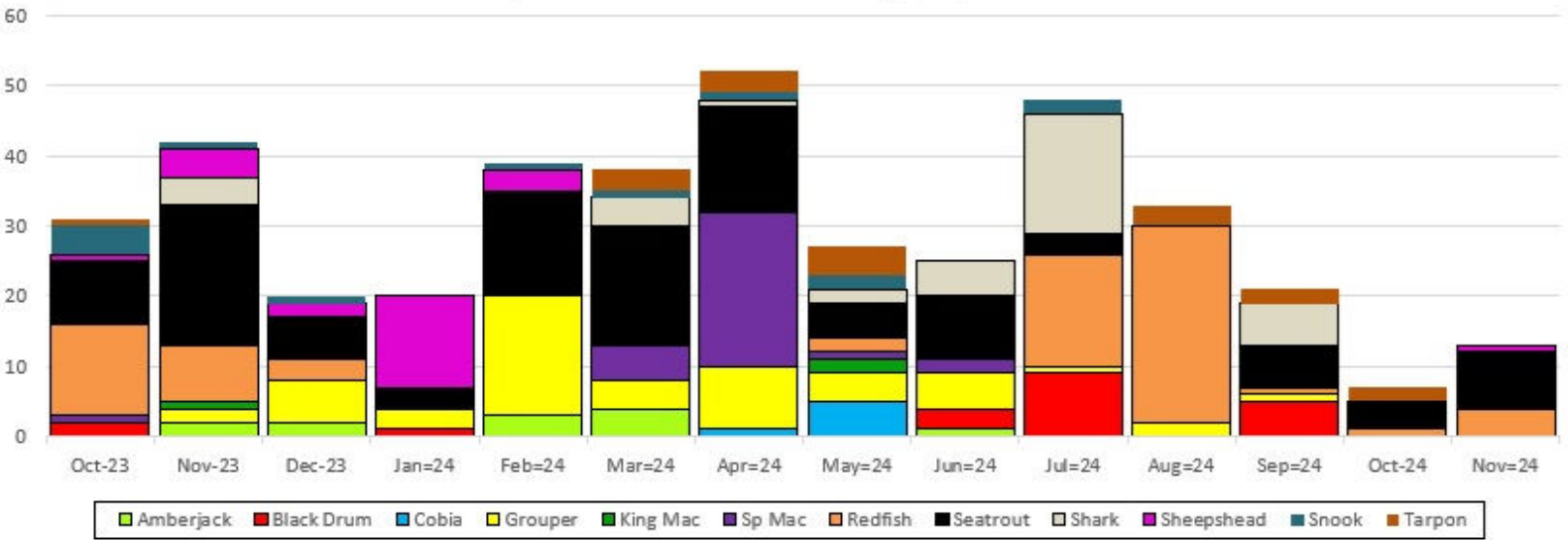
