FISHING REPORT For OCTOBER

Offshore:

King Mackerel have shown up in nearshore Gulf waters. Some have even been caught in the Harbor! Reports include multiple fish in the 30 inch range. Best baits include spoons and hard baits trolled. Wire rigged ballyhoo will also produce. A wire bite leader is a must! Consider extending the length of the bite leader as the Kings can be quite aggressive and have even attacked planer boards and in-line sinkers. When trolling consider offering a cedar plug; there could be Blackfin Tuna or Bonita in the mix. There will almost certainly be plenty of Spanish Mackerel around too. Dangling live bait, especially blue runners, can also be productive for Kings.

Familiarize yourself with the subtle differences between the Spanish and the Kings. This is important as the size and bag limits are different. Spanish are 12 inches, 15 fish; Kings are 24 inches; 3 fish. Length is measured as a fork measurement. King Mackerel grow a lot bigger than their Spanish relatives. However, before they mature, juvenile Kingfish are often very similar in size to grown Spanish Mackerel. Also, Spanish Mackerel have three rows of elliptical yellow spots dotting the sides of their bodies. King Mackerel don't, at least when they're fully grown. Juvenile Kings, however, boast these very same yellow spots. When they mature, the spots on King Mackerel either lose their color or fade into a leopard-like pattern.

For all their similarities, there are a couple of key features that differentiate King Mackerel vs. Spanish Mackerel. These are:

- The lateral line on a King Mackerel drops sharply near the first dorsal fin. On a Spanish Mackerel, this line slopes down much more evenly.
- The first dorsal fin on a King Mackerel is lightly-colored across its length. On a Spanish Mackerel, the front end of the first dorsal is distinctively black.

These fish are fun to catch and taste great either fresh or smoked. Go out and get some!

Remember to have a descending plan for those fish that don't meet the minimum size limit for harvest. The best method is to actually descend the fish using one of the descending devices. By law, you must have this equipment on board and use it. Also note that grouper are not the only fish that require descending, Red and Lane Snapper caught at depth will also experience barotrauma.

NOTE: Greater Amberjack has been closed for harvest for the remainder of 2025.

FISHING REPORT For OCTOBER

(Fish Report, continued)

Inshore:

The recent weather change is not only comfortable, but is causing fish to move. The tarpon while still available are on the move. This angler witnessed a "free jumper" in Boca Pass recently.

Snook is open for harvest through November in Charlotte Harbor. If you haven't eaten Snook this is your chance. The hard part is getting one in the slot (28-33 inches). The limit is one fish. The Snook have been cooperative, hitting live bait and artificial lures. Expect the best fish on or near structure and under cover of mangroves or docks.

Redfish are still being caught. Target Reds or near mangroves using live bait, cut bait or lures. Red Drum are also good table fare. The slot for these is 18-27 inches, one fish (max of 2 fish per boat).

Spanish Mackerel are also available, often mixed with Jack Crevalle. Some nice catches are still available with points fish being caught. Locate schools with bird/bait activity and/or by fishing structure. Trolling small spoons can make for some good catching.





Fish of the Month For NOVEMBER

Location, Description, Tips, Tackle and Bait

MANGROVE SNAPPER



Identification:

- Dark brown or gray in color, with red-orange spots in bars along the sides
- Two large canine teeth near front of upper jaw
- Anchor-shaped vomerine tooth patch
- Dorsal fins with dark or reddish borders
- Young have dark stripe from snout, through eye, to upper edge of gill cover

Locations/Behavior:

- Found near structure such as reefs, mangroves, docks, and seagrass.
- Bigger snapper found on off-shore/near-shore reefs and hard bottom
- Eat a variety of bait: shrimp, soft plastics, trolling lures, fish bites, white bait, etc. Larger mangrove snapper off-shore/near-shore take live bait, squid, shrimp (love cigar minnows).
- The bite is hard and fast. They are aggressive eaters and swimmers.
- Spawn June August

Technique:

- Set the hook quick; otherwise, your bait will be stolen
- Cast at docks/pilling during medium and high tides. Be ready for them to bite the bait is falling.
- During lower tides they often are a few feet from the dock or pilings.

Gear/rigging:

- In-shore light gear, smaller hook or jighead. 10-15 lb braid and 10 15 lb leader.
- Off-shore/Near-shore "grouper set up" or other heavier gear.

Interesting Tidbits

So glad to have many of our seasonal anglers returning which meant our total submissions was double the amount from the previous month. The fish of the month, Redfish, remained rather elusive with only 3 reported catches. Seatrout and Spanish Mackerel were regular submissions with the toothy critters up to 25" fork length. Cobia showed up in the harbor and provided exhausting fun for those lucky anglers on the water who found them schooled up, the largest reported at 47" fork length. A pleasantly surprising number of King Mackerel were reported by several anglers, in fact, there have not been this many Kings reported in one month for many years. While none reported were smokers, the largest was a 32" fork length species. Mark Cummins became the 47th angler in the Club's history to achieve the coveted Master Angler classification – Congratulations!. We also welcome first submissions by new Club members Carlos Avila and David Morgan

For those of you looking forward to chasing American Red Snapper, the fall season will include the following dates: Nov. 11 (Veterans Day); Nov. 14-16; Nov. 21-23; Nov. 27-30 (Thanksgiving weekend); Dec. 5-7; Dec. 12-14; Dec. 19-21; Dec. 25-28 (Christmas weekend).



If you get a notice that your Fishing Club membership has dropped and you think that might be an error, please contact me by email or phone.


